Under the International Health Regulations, all travellers from Kenya or Uganda must produce a Certificate of Vaccination against Smallpox and Measles and proof of having been vaccinated against Typhoid.

TRAVELLER'S HOTEL
Regulation Officers will accept the International Health Certificate only if it is valid for at least six months. They may however accept other documents issued by the International Health Commission in all countries.

YELLOW FEVER
Travellers from Kenya or Uganda must produce a Yellow Fever certificate only if it is valid for at least six months. They may however accept other documents issued by the International Health Commission in all countries.

IMMUNITIES MAY BE OBTAINED
In the U.S.A. only the Young Men's Christian Association, YMCA, 1201 Avenue of the Americas, New York, N.Y. 10001, and the American Red Cross, 1700 Broadway, New York, N.Y. 10019, can issue International Health Certificates.

Proof of a vaccination against Yellow Fever can be obtained from the U.S. Consulate General, Nairobi.

Persons making the pilgrimage to Mecca may obtain an International Health Certificate from the U.S. Consulate General, Jeddah.

IMMUNITIES MAY BE OBTAINED
In the U.S.A. only the Young Men's Christian Association, YMCA, 1201 Avenue of the Americas, New York, N.Y. 10001, and the American Red Cross, 1700 Broadway, New York, N.Y. 10019, can issue International Health Certificates.

Yellow Fever only

Travellers from Kenya or Uganda must produce a Yellow Fever certificate only if it is valid for at least six months. They may however accept other documents issued by the International Health Commission in all countries.
