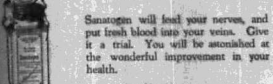

£4,000,000 EXPORTED FROM TANGANYIKA

RECORD FIGURES FOR LAST YEAR

Huge Increases

SISAL, COTTON AND GOLD PROVIDED MOST OF TOTAL

Last year, for the first time in the history of Tanganyika, the value of domestic exports passed the four million pounds mark.

Record values were reached in the exports of sisal, cotton and gold, which represented a combined value equal to over three million pounds. The cotton output was more than twice that of 1932, and gold exports increased by 34 per cent. in quantity over 1935.

Favourable Balance

The growth of trade in Tanganyika Territory is reflected in the Trade Report for 1936 which has just been issued. The value of the volume of trade at £4,000,000 is a noteworthy double what it was five years ago, and the increase over the previous year amounts to £1,460,000. The total value of the balance of trade is within £450,000 of the last mentioned figure, and shows an increase of 45 per cent.

The following passages are extracted from the report: "For the first time in the history of the territory, the value of domestic exports has passed the four million mark. The highest previous figure was £2,570,000 in 1935. An increase of 56 per cent. has been recorded with 1935 the increase for the year was £1,071,181 or 41%." "Trade imports did not improve in the same proportion. The increase of £288,267 or 12% over 1935 is less than might have been expected from the favourable visible trade balance of the four past years and indicates continued caution in trading and development."

"In the percentage of total trade the United Kingdom was still the biggest supplier with 25.2% against 20% the previous year. Germany showed the largest increase, from 10.7 in 1935 to 14.1 last year, while Japan's share rose from 2% to 25.3%."

"There was another increase of over six million pounds in the total imports of cotton piece goods, the value being higher by about £47,000."

Sisal Prices

"Domestic prices increased in value to £4,316,284 in 1936 as against £1,971,181 in 1935. Record values were reached in the exports of sisal, cotton, and gold which represented a combined value of over three million pounds, equivalent to two-thirds of the total domestic exports of the year. With improved prices and records in production output, recorded in the same month, and in some old plant, an overall 45 per cent. increase in value is shown for the year. The value of No. 1 sisal over the year was about £27.10 per ton, a price which encouraged planting and development schemes and the over-

low lying areas. There was, nevertheless, an increase of nearly one-third in the exports of rice, which constituted another record. As with other grains, prices were generally lower, the total value showing an increase of only 10%.

"The market for hides was particularly active throughout the year and a fall of 1.2 per cent. was more than made up by higher prices, resulting in an increase of 22.6 per cent. in the total value. The exports of skins, which were recorded separately for the first time in 1936, showed an increase of 63.7 per cent. in quantity and 133.3 per cent. in value. The improvement in demand and price is partly attributed to the cessation of sales from Abyssinia as a result of the recent war. The exports of skins exceeded the previous record of 1931 and were 17.3 per cent. higher than in 1935."

Gold Exports

"Gold exports increased by 34 per cent. in quantity and 22 per cent. in value, the greatest advance being in reef gold. Production of alluvial gold in Mtwara district has been assisted by the introduction of a larger number of machines."

"The planting of groundnuts was a firm demand, with the most intensive sowing on the world's market, the total value exported being the highest on record with the exception of 1934. The increased demand for groundnuts throughout the year extended to seasons, the exports of which exceeded those of 1935 by 15% in quantity and 20% in value. Heavy climatic conditions gave promise of a large increase in the production of all crops, but excessive rain in April and May caused serious flooding and damage to crops in the lowlands."

Timber Increases

"The exports of timber were high by 24 per cent. in quantity and 42 per cent. in value, although imports from Kenya and Uganda during the year decreased from £8,600 to £6,400 cubic feet. "A comparison with 1935, however, shows an increase from £278,345 to £380,074. The total does not include hollow and specie values, at £210,158 or 54 per cent. of a value of £387."

"The total collection of customs revenue amounted to £795,500 as compared with £704,141 in 1935, showing a further reduction in the departmental cost of collection. The cost from import duties was about 14 per cent. higher than in the previous year and came second to the record total of £708,097 in 1935."

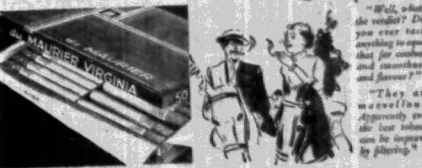

New L.B.W. Rule

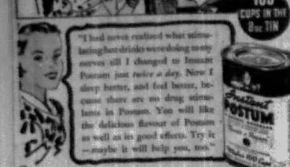
The experimental L.B.W. rule related to new law. The M.C.C. voted unanimously in favour of the rule becoming permanent. Law 24 new reads:—

THE SQUATTERS BILL: LOCAL OPTION To the Editor, "F. A. Standard."

Sir—The views of Mr. Gilbert Walker on the new Squatters Bill are so opposed to the law, and believe a majority of squatters farmers in this district, that it appears desirable to record dissent from his opinion. The Bill proposed for criticism reached the form with the aid of capable outside professional. It may not be perfect, but it is attempts to deal with a pressing problem, which, if not watched carefully, may in time make an end of European settlement.

The Bill introduces the principle, long desired, of local option, by which the rights of the majority in any area (District Council or District Committee) or any suitable area of the same, may regulate the maximum of native residential land within its bounds. This, in my view, is fair and reasonable. It allows any land and land, suitable for particular areas or any areas being touched on either district where the inhabitants resident would prefer land.

Hoare, Minister of Finance, South Africa, and the Shipping Committee, under the chairmanship of Mr. W. Nash, the New Zealand representative.

The heads of the delegations will meet tomorrow to consider, among other things, the shipping conference.

TANA AND MARAGUA FLOODS AS SEEN FROM AN AERO PLANE

Waterfall which Dwarfs the Muchison Falls

Accounts of the spectacular flooding of the flooded Maragua and Tana Rivers on Monday morning which the East African Power and Lighting Company's main power station at the junction of the two rivers was forced to close down owing to flood water entering the power house, have been amplified from Mr. Macnevel, Maxwell, who together with the chief engineer of the Company and a photographer, flew over the area shortly before noon on Sunday. Small lakes, said Mr. Maxwell, were formed in several places well above the river channels. The most significant fact was that the Maragua River had brought down with it large quantities of top soil which had apparently never before been touched by flood water. The cleaning out of the Maragua-Tana power station is proceeding apace, and it is hoped that the machinery will shortly be ready to start work again.

Investigation by early Mr. Maxwell stated that early on Sunday morning the Engineer at the Maragua-Tana power house—the main power station of the East African Power and Lighting Company—reported the river had risen and that water was entering the building.

Apparently the water rose to a depth of four feet over the floor of the power house. The Company's chief engineer at the Nairobi district charged an expedition and a mile into the river.

Mr. Manning said this was by Ireland and in Dublin, the President as the King's representative.







Royal Speeches at Budapest

The collaboration of Germany with the Rome Protocol countries, Italy, Hungary and Austria, was emphasized when the King of Italy and Admiral Horthy, the Regent of Hungary, spoke at a State banquet here last night.

Addressing the toast of "King Victor Emmanuel," Admiral Horthy declared that the policy of the Rome Protocols would not only ensure the welfare of Hungary but also the general well-being of all States, would establish the pillars of real lasting peace and harmonious co-operation among the nations.

In reply, the King spoke of the value of the Protocols, and referred to the "lovely cooperation of the German Reich." He added that Hungary had in "Fascist Imperial Italy" a friend on whom she could rely implicitly.

ABOLISH GAS FIRST

German Suggestion for Dismantling

One Thing at a Time

SUGGESTION BY U.S. AMBASSADOR

The suggestion of a new approach to disarmament by agreeing to the abolition of one weapon at a time beginning with poison gas, certain types of bombs, and proceeding to the general outlawing of all arms, was made by the new American ambassador, Dr. Dieckhoff when he received members of the Press.

He said that Germany now believed that she had received shattering arms equality, and Her Majesty had often declared his readiness to discuss disarmament when that point had been reached.

OFFER TO BASQUES BY FRANCO

Joint Government if They Surrender

General Franco dispatched a protest note to the Basques Government on May 17, according to the highest authority, promising that if the Basques surrender, he will respect all laws and property and guarantee the freedom of those holding office before the civil war.

He proposes a joint Junta-Basque study of reasonable political and economic administration and has also proposed his former proposal of a neutral zone in which civilians might be evacuated.

If the Basques reject the offer, Franco promises that a neutral zone should still be set up to prevent the infiltration by hill-gangs.

After meeting for barely two hours, the principal delegates to the Imperial Conference adjourned until Friday.

In addition to appointing a committee on constitutional questions, the meeting selected to a long, objective review of the international situation by Mr. Eden going back to the peace treaty.

Tribute to Empire

"WHEN ARMED, WILL BE GREATEST GUARANTEED OF PEACE"

President Roosevelt's representative at the Coronation, Mr. James Roosevelt, speaking at a dinner in his honour in London last night, said that they had come many miles to see the great ceremony, which was not only the consecration and coronation of one individual, the King, but was the consecration of a great Empire, held together in more permanent bonds than ever before in its history.

"You are arming sadly, reluctantly, but with determination. But when you are armed, then an armed Britain will be the greatest guarantee of peace on earth."

"We in America are firmly determined on three things. Firstly, we are against war; secondly, we are against any alliances and thirdly, we are against meddling in the muddled affairs of Europe. But we and you, the great British Empire, are bound by something more binding than alliances and treaties. We are bound together by mutual trust, by mutual understanding, by common desires for stability and peace, and especially by the feeling that at this moment, with Fascism on the one side and Communism on the other, the three great democracies, Britain, France and the United States, stand as the sole hope of liberalism and of freedom in the world.—British Official Wireless Service.

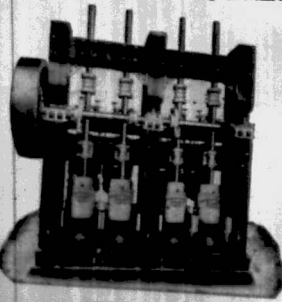

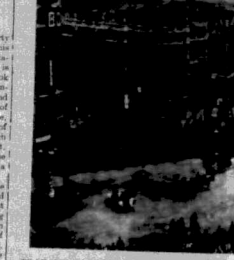
