## MOROCCO TRIUMPHS FOR FRENCH CABINET

Street fights after soldiers protest over North Africa

### Assembly supports policy of reform

#### 30,000 TRIBESMEN FACE TROOPS IN MOUNTAINS

JUST BEFORE dawn yesterday the French Government, after three and a half days of difficult debate, secured a triumph in obtaining an unofficial endorsement of its Moroccan reform policy by the National Assembly.

The French Premier, M. Faure, gave a "blood and guts" warning to Deputies during his 110-hour appeal for support. He asked them to decide whether they agreed with the formation of a Moroccan Government for administration of internal affairs and for negotiating with the French Government on a basis of "national independence" within the framework of Franco-Moroccan interdependence.

The French Defence Minister, Gen. Pierre Billotte, left Rabat for Paris yesterday to report on his visit to the 30,000 rebel tribesmen now challenged between 30,000 French troops in the Rif Mountains. French Army resistance troops in the Rif and the Middle Atlas have lost 500 men and 17 dead and 59 wounded. About 500 rebel bands have been formed.

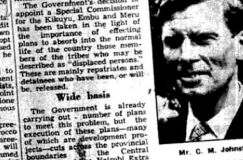

# Wider application of sedition law

## OATH ADMINISTRATION TO BE CAPITAL OFFENCE

CHANGES to widen the application of the law regarding sedition and making the administration of oaths to permit capital offences punishable by death are suggested in a Bill to amend the Kenya Penal Code.

At present persons attending and administering or consenting to the administration of such oaths are liable to imprisonment. It is stated that circumstances warrant the inclusion of the death sentence for such administrators, although its continuance in the code will not require constant consideration.

If the Bill becomes law, imprisonment will still be enforceable for people attending with ceremonies or taking oaths without being compelled to do so.

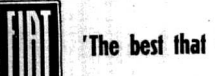

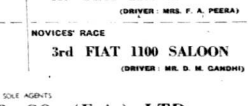

# AFRICAN EDUCATION PROGRESS

## AND PROBLEMS

Rapid expansion a threat to teaching standards

DISPITE the effects of the Emergency on African education in the disturbed areas, there was a steady increase in the annual intake of the Kenya Education Department in some areas last year, except in the pro-Government areas.

Attacks on schools and teachers continued during the early part of the year, the report says. Schools were burnt down in the disturbed areas, and many teachers were injured. But with the increase in security forces, police and administrative staff, the more effective action was possible against subversive activities in schools.

During the year, 123 African teachers were detained for association with Mau Mau and 40 were arrested for the Emergency Regulations.

The report points out the problems of rapid expansion, with a consequent lowering of the standard of teachers, but notes the progress that has been made in technical education and the good response to it by African pupils.

**Examination results**  
It gives details of the results of pupils who sat for the departmental Kenya African Preliminary Examination at the end of their intermediate course last year. Of the 5,003 boys and 812 girls who sat, 2,212 boys and 512 girls passed.

These results show a disappointing falling of educational standards, which it due to the rapid expansion of the intermediate school. It is a fact that a large number of teachers employed in the schools and with an increased demand for them, there has been a smaller number of pupils.

Attempts are being made to solve this problem by expansion of the intermediate school. The influence of European staff in the schools is shown by the girls results, which are comparatively better than those of the boys.

**Employment problem**  
Of the 500,000 candidates, 257 boys and 78 girls were admitted to secondary schools and 173 boys and 362 girls to technical schools. Many were admitted to departmental training centres.

There is, however, a reliance on the part of employers to engage members of the Kenya African Middle Class Association as employees is becoming a serious problem.

The Emergency also has an effect on the external activities of schools, the report continues, and the number of pupils has risen from 41 in 1954 to 199 in 1955.
