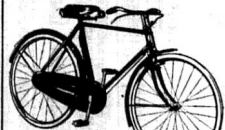

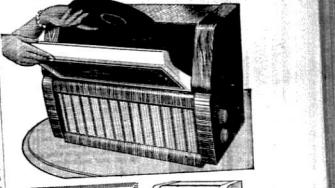

CHANCELLOR ABOLISHES BRITISH HOUSING SUBSIDIES

Emergency Budget raises purchase tax on 'SPENDTHRIFT PROFITS'

MEASURES designed to make Britons spend less and earn more were introduced by the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. R. A. Butler, in the Emergency Budget which he presented to the House of Commons yesterday.

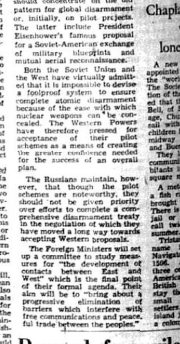

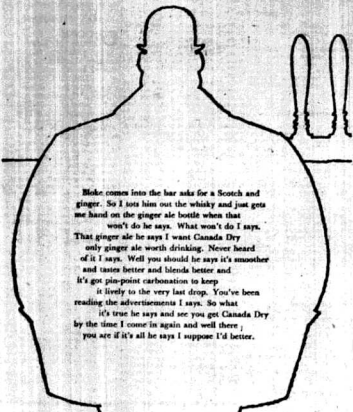

URGENT NEED FOR TEACHERS' TRAINING SCHOOLS

Female education delayed

KENYA LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL unanimously approved on Thursday a resolution recording its opinion that the construction of two African women's teacher training colleges had become a matter of great urgency.

Reasons for delay in the construction of the two colleges—one at Machakos and the other in Nyanza Province—were given by the Director of Education, W. D. Wadley, who said it was hoped that the buildings would be ready for occupation not later than January, 1957.

The motion was brought by Mr. H. B. B. (Kenya) who stated that a definite decision to establish a college at Machakos was mentioned in the report of the Legislative Council a year ago.

Extra expense
It would be apparent that female education could not be developed as an adequate teacher.

Mr. C. G. Usher (Mombasa) stated that the cost of the two colleges would be in excess of 27,000 boys. In the primary schools the cost was still greater.

Reasons for the delay might be that there is a lack of trained teachers. Nevertheless, more teachers were required for the girls, who were extremely responsive to education.

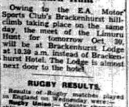

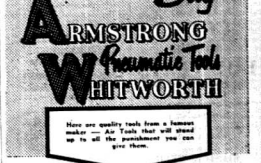

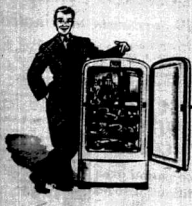
