EARLY ELECTIONS PROBABLE IN FRANCE

318-218 vote leads to Government fall

DEFEAT MAY BRING M. FAURE VICTORY

FRANCE'S 21st post-war Government, headed by M. Faure, was defeated in the National Assembly by 318 votes to 218 on a procedural issue linked with the Prime Minister's plan for February elections. Talks were proceeding yesterday.

The Minister of Housing, Senator Roger Duchet, died during the debate but the 29 Cabinet Ministers were in favour of dissolving Parliament. With a majority of 218, the Government has the right to ask for early elections in 18 months by an absolute majority. Mr. Faure from putting through his Opposition to early elections and after overthrown him for the position to do what the defeated Premier, with five votes more to his credit in the last eight weeks, has been unable to achieve.

Sir Winston 81: Birthday fund reaches £259,000

Sir Winston Churchill was 81 yesterday. He learned that a special presentation fund launched last year on his 80th birthday has now reached £259,000.

Members of the public from all parts of the world have contributed to the fund. Sir Winston has said he has no objection to the sum being used to help the work of the War Relieff Committee.

Formerly gathering
The former Premier spent the morning in the company of his wife and children and opened the 81st birthday party at the Grosvenor Hotel. He was accompanied by Mrs. Mary, Mrs. Joan, and Mrs. Pamela Churchill.

At the party, which was held in the morning, Sir Winston was surrounded by a large number of guests. He was seen to be in excellent health and spirits.

Mr. Khrushchev said that the Soviet Union is prepared to accept a ban on atomic weapons if the Western powers do the same.

The police are investigating the death. It is believed that the man may have been suffering from a heart condition.

He called for a united front against the Soviet Union's nuclear program.

Electronic 'brain' makes translations MACHINE OVERCOMES PROBLEM OF IDIOMATIC PHRASES

BRITISH scientists working on electronic computers have performed a method of translating languages by mechanical means. Using a 200-valve computer, they have devised procedures already for rendering a French text into English and for dealing with idiomatic phrases—once thought to be the chief obstacle to any method of 'mechanical' translation.

This is disclosed in the tenth annual report of the Nuffield Foundation published yesterday. The report shows that more than £200,000 was spent on grants during the years 1954-55 or nearly three times the sum spent on the first year of the foundation's work in 1954.

CEREMONY ON ANNIVERSARY OF KABAKA'S DEPORTATION

GRAND OF £7,200 attended the ceremony at the Kabaka's College, London, for the past year on automatic translation by an electronic machine, in charge of the project is Dr. A. D. Booth, head of the project's computer laboratory.

The ceremony was held to mark the anniversary of the Kabaka's deportation. It was a significant event for the community.

The Christmas story in plan. Whaling Fleets From Six Nations To Sail For Antarctic.

SEVENTEEN whaling fleets from six countries are preparing for the new Antarctic summer catch-up season which promises to be one of the shortest and most competitive in whale oil history. Many more fast motor whalers are being sent down to the ice this season to hunt down a limited number of whales as it can do so fast as possible when the killing season opens in January. Last year, from January 1st to March 1st, two and a half months' hunting changed fewer whales than in any other Antarctic summer short.

Three factory ships will carry "spitter" helicopters to scout the whaling harvest for ice-free districts killing as well as the standard whaling. Cape Town is expecting whaling ships Blenheim, William Croft and the British whaler of the Sudary and other ways to the ice. The British whaler of the Sudary is already on its long cruise across the world to Odessa was due to pass Cape Town on its way to the ice.

ZANZIBAR'S ESTIMATES SHOW DEFICIT

'No need for immediate increase in taxation'

ZANZIBAR'S total, planned expenditure for 1956, in both professional and development estimates, exceeded total revenue by £205,000, said Mr. A. H. Hawker, the acting Financial Secretary, when he introduced the approval of the development programme draft estimates in Zanzibar Legislative Council.

Moving the reference of the Protectorate estimates to the Standing Finance Committee, the acting Secretary, Mr. P. H. Nightingale, said the general impression was that there was no immediate need for increased taxation. The debate on the Protectorate and development estimates were adjourned until Wednesday.

Dealing with the Protectorate estimates, Mr. Nightingale said that, stated under the probable expenditure for next year, existing provisions from £45,000 to £15,000, was that there would be a surplus of revenue over expenditure of £31,000.

Surpluses misleading. It, however, they took into account the £100,000 to be expended to spend from surplus balances, the final surplus would be an overall deficit of just over £200,000. The revenue estimates for next year, which included a 10 per cent of total revenue, were high, according to Mr. Nightingale, but it was not an increase in establishment, but it was on the whole a 10 per cent increase of expenditure.

FACTORY WHERE AFRICANS PROVE THEIR WORTH

A FULLY mechanized carpenter's shop, in transforms great logs straight from the forest into neat, strong and well-made doors, at the rate of 20 a day in the pride of the Nairobi office of the Nyanza Timber and Hardware Company, whose mills, stores and timber yards are spread over a large part of the Nairobi industrial area.

Today the west and east of the circuit saw provide a distinctive background to a most important subsidiary of the Kenya building industry and very soon the tempo will be even faster for the company has just secured the contract for one of its biggest-ever single orders.

Fine art

DOOR-BUILDING is an industry which has been brought to a fine art in the Nyanza Timber factory and the artists are mostly skilled and highly paid Africans who, by left handlings of complicated machinery, prove daily that no one race has cornered the market in adaptability. Logs of cedar and pine, which arrive by rail from Kisumu,

Thomson's Falls and other up-country areas, begin their machining journey through the sawing and planing stages on to a machine which cuts the logs into sections of varying thicknesses.

The first machine, which really goes down to the business of cutting doors, is a four-cutter, which cuts a groove in the edge of the board, and can cut four sections simultaneously.

A skilfully handled operator and his crew then take over, sawing, anything from six inches for doors to four square to 18 feet lengths for special orders from hotels and public buildings.

When cut and sized, the posts are stacked systematically to dry. From these stacks, the wood is taken to a machine which has a saw in its edge the instant wood is fed the grooves are already made. Precision adjusters on the machine will make from 150 to 200 thousand an hour, in the meantime, making on the same machinery but also in the same operation, controlled by a row of buttons, door sashes and prepared for fitting across the four frames of about 18 x 8 strength and softness.

All is now ready for the door to be assembled by hand. On a large table the doors are fitted together, the sashes are laid across horizontally, a

special glue, imported from Britain is brushed around the surface of the framework and poured into all the joints.

On the surface of the framework is laid a sheet of plywood cut roughly to size. This is heated flat above the door is turned over and a similar sheet is placed on the other side. The wood is imported from Norway and countries including timber and plywood from West Africa, pine from Sweden and birch from Czechoslovakia.

In large presses, blades of special steel are subjected to heavy pressure for two to three hours to ensure that all joints are tight, and then, almost perfectly, the door is laid on a splinter machine which cuts away the surplus of the plywood and framework, making them perfectly flush.

Standing in deep beds by hand and by machine, and through a series of rollers, the doors are to be perfect one after another, the essential the fitting of holes at each end of the door to fit all which would otherwise be trapped, and would be liable to cause warping.

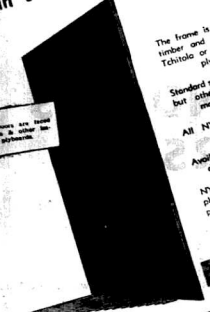

On New Factories**

EAST AFRICA'S only steel window-frame manufacturing company is at Mombasa. It is called Kenya Casements Ltd., and it produces something like 12,000 frames every month.

The company will be one of the biggest concerns in the three Territories within the next three years. It will then be one of the finest examples of enterprise in this part of the world.

And the main principle responsible for this development is Mr. Chalmers Pugh, the managing director. He was himself an importer of steel window frames and doors at Mombasa. He was in business in a comfortable way, and realised that the demand for his wares in East Africa was such that a local factory to produce it would be a fair return proposition.

Now right ahead. In July, 1954, the Kenya Casements Ltd. began to turn out its first steel window frames from rented premises in the light industrial area at Mombasa. But the orders do not only come from concrete in Kenya. The company exports large quantities of window frames and doors to Tanganyika and Malawi. It also sends quantities in Uganda, and is negotiating to extend its market to Malawi, the Belgian Congo, Somaliland and Abyssinia.

To cover such a large field is not an easy task. The company has therefore, appointed 15 of its main agents, Messrs. Smith, Mackenzie and Co. Ltd., a concern which has 40 agents in addition to the main agents, sub-agents have also been appointed in all areas to deal

with the enormous public and small collections. This system is showing good results. The company's derived from locally manufactured window frames and doors are obvious. Apart from compliance with full British standard specifications, they can be serviced on the spot when servicing is required. Prices and the delivery of locally produced goods compare very favourably with the imported article as well.

All the machinery used by the Kenya Casements Ltd. is of the latest type. It is exactly the same as that used by the most important casement manufacturers in the United Kingdom.

The steel sections used by the company—500 long 4-inch sections— are produced by the biggest and most important steel sections rolling mill in Britain. At the present time the Kenya Casements Ltd. occupies a large building, covering 42,000 square feet. This building was erected in 1954.

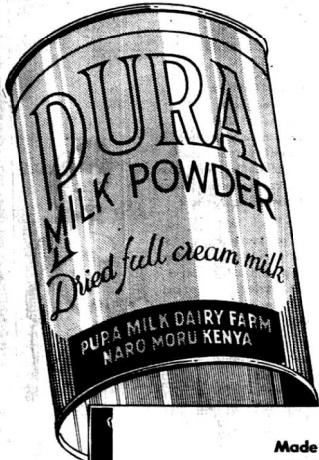

The Premier, Sir Anthony Eden, replying to questions in the House, said that the problem of controlling explosions of hydrogen and atomic weapons was "not a matter of emotion but a technical problem of very great difficulty."

Mr. Arthur Henderson (Labour) urged Sir Anthony to take the lead in proposing a conference between the President Eisenhower and Marshal Stalin to discuss all nuclear explosions pending a U.N. report on the form of radiation. The Premier replied that he had not seen and did not know of any such proposal.

He said that the General Assembly had last year adopted a resolution on the subject of Foreign Secretary, Mr. Eden, said that the Russians had not yet agreed to a ban on all nuclear weapons, but that they had agreed to a ban on international nuclear weapons, and that the Government was still working on the matter.

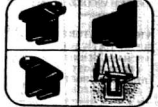
