To the Editor, "E.A. Standard":

For many years now the readers of your Financial Page have been treated to some interesting dissertations on the financial affairs of the people of Britain. One of the most interesting, I think, is that by the Government, in which they say that this country is rich enough to afford all the most important services to its people. We have been reading that one of the reasons why successive British governments, from the time of Mr. Attlee, have made the people of Britain richer is that they have been prosperous, and that, if we could do more of the same, then calls for strong government would cease.

SRAELI ASSAULT ON SYRIAN OUTPOSTS

**55 killed in night
retaliation raid**

INCIDENT SEEN AS TEST OF PACT WITH EGYPT

**UNDER cover of heavy
artillery, Israeli troops
attacked Syrian outposts over
the Golan Heights in a surprise
retaliatory raid on Sunday night,**

A military spokesman in Jerusalem said four Israeli soldiers were killed and 200 others wounded when the armistice line north-east of the Jordan River was crossed by artillery, surprise air attack, and tanks. The Syrians recovered and held their ground until daylight took place for about an hour.

Four Israeli aircraft bombers flew up the fortress-controlled and their

targets at the largest settlement at Ein Gev and Israeli artillery returned fire.





I acted as liaison officer between the then Minister of State and the Chief Secretary. He was satisfied with my work and nothing got past him that would interfere with or restrict the African's hunting and the unashamed slaughter of wild animals. Cameron's time as Governor.

The then Elephant Control Board was responsible for the game preserve distribution to the native tribes. Mr. C. F. M. Symonson, Game Warden, was the present Game Warden to re-establish the Central Game Reserve and without this there would have continued the Game Olympics. All officials knew the policy of the Government and the campaigns of unrestricted hunting. The native tribes were now amenable to man's laws. It is time the Royal Society of the Elephants took action. I have been found by a European magazine to be the author of the article. I have heard of 45 animals, including lions, elephants, etc., killed in the last 10 months. The natives are still hunting. The line of poachers will continue to hunt until the day the last animal is shot. There were other reasons for the closure of the game parks.

It is true that the Government has a battery of Native Affairs officers who have been carrying out their work of which I must have reached a conclusion that the Government had to make up its mind to close the parks. I have heard of 45 animals, including lions, elephants, etc., killed in the last 10 months. The natives are still hunting. The line of poachers will continue to hunt until the day the last animal is shot. There were other reasons for the closure of the game parks.

I have, of course, that should have planned or seen the closure of the parks in my pocket for safety, but, as far as I am concerned, if some plain clothes police officers had been sent to the park would soon receive their orders.
