# Introduction of a new rice to Kikuyuland

## RICE'S PART IN RESETTLEMENT

**RICE** is an entirely new crop in the Kikuyu country of Kenya, it being cultivated on the extensive Mwea Plains, south of Mount Kenya. It will play a vital part in the resettlement of thousands of Kikuyu families with no land of their own. Many of the Kikuyu who will be allocated plots on this big new rice-estate are coming out of Mau Mau work camps. Before they can get any of this land, however, the seeds of the landless Kikuyu must first be met.

**Intensified** the ambitious Kikuyu plan to have a rice-estate available from British funds had led to the Mwea Plains, was nearly strangled at birth by the Mau Mau terrorists themselves.

### Terrestrial detour

The years set upon their activity in the Mwea District were not without their fruits. The natural Department started an experimental rice plot which was producing successful results. But the Mau Mau attack, and as it has struck at other centres to almost a halting process to almost a complete cessation of agricultural activities was suspended; the rice plot survived and all the valuable records destroyed.
