Yesterday I was the principal father of three children in a primary school class - the usual African way of doing it - I was the principal teacher, my wife/assistant, today/assistant teacher.

My wife is now a housewife, she has no income. I have to pay for my children's school fees, my own living expenses, and the household expenses.

Last year I was visited by the Inspector General of Education for No. 1 and 24, part of the European primary school at 215 per year each for which I was allowed to claim an education allowance of 200 of the tuition fee. My total allowance, therefore, was £215. Last year the total allowance was £400.

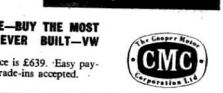

The scheme would not only provide a means for localisation and training to proceed rapidly, but also give designated officers who were being displaced the time needed to find other work. Many would be needed for years to come.

Emperor backs tremendous strides made in field of education

FOR all people in Ethiopia, and indeed for all Ethiopians wherever they may be, July is the time to look back and count the good things of the old year, look forward and plan better things for the new. For July is the month in which Emperor Haile Selassie I was born. Yesterday, July 23, celebrations took place in Ethiopia and in countries where the Emperor is represented, to commemorate his 66th birthday.

Born on July 23, 1892, Emperor Haile Selassie is a great grandson of King Salote Selassie and is a descendant of King Solomon and the Queen of Sheba. The Emperor, a descendant of the oldest and longest Royal line in recorded history, ascended the throne on November 2, 1930.

The Emperor is a born demagogue, a fact which he has been demonstrating ever since he became the present Emperor in 1930. He has always looked to the people with whom he identifies himself in his everyday life.

At schools, the Emperor, never fails to take an interest in the students' point of view. On his 66th Commemorative Anniversary, he declared: "I have had many suggestions for the education of our youth. It is because we are convinced that only through intellectual progress and universal education can Ethiopia come into its own."

PRIDE OF PLACE

Throughout these years the Emperor has emphasized the paramount importance of education and has given this field of progress pride of place in Ethiopian development.

His visits to schools and colleges made to inform himself of educational problems and to give advice and encouragement to both staff and pupils, have become regular features of his life.

Looking back, one sees a very different picture of Ethiopia after the war, with Italy. The progress in Ethiopia, in educational, economic and social aspects, can

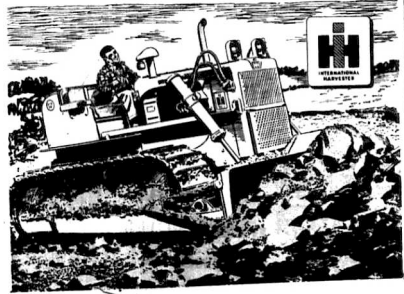

Five-year plan speeds economic advance

Ethiopia's economic advance is being speeded by encouraging investment and modernizing agricultural methods under a Five-Year Development Plan.

OVER the past few years the Ethiopian Government has made an extensive and intensive study of the country's economy and its potentialities for future development.

On the basis of this study a Five-Year Development Plan has been drawn up as an "economic compass" to guide the country towards economic development. The main objectives and tasks of this plan have been listed as follows:

1. To direct economic policy, particularly financial and investment, in order to mobilize the maximum resources of the country for development and to utilize foreign capital to the fullest extent possible.
2. To raise the level of living in general and to create the necessary conditions for the expansion of the country's economic base.
3. To carry out the plan in the light of the country's resources and capabilities, and to ensure that the plan is carried out in a systematic and coordinated manner.
4. To ensure that the plan is carried out in a way which will bring about the maximum benefit to the people of Ethiopia.

The first objective of the plan is to direct economic policy. This is done by the Ministry of Economic Development, which is responsible for the formulation and implementation of the plan. The Ministry also oversees the work of the various government departments and agencies which are involved in the execution of the plan.

Among the tasks being carried out under the plan is the reclamation of more land for agriculture. This is being done by the construction of dams and irrigation systems, which will enable a much greater area of land to be brought under cultivation.

Under the plan, the Government is encouraging investment in Ethiopia by foreign firms. This is being done by offering incentives and subsidies to foreign investors.

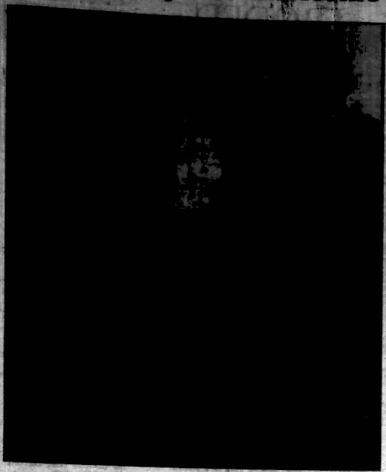
