WOMEN WARE ENGLISH CAPITAL

Shield for thugs, say police

HUNDREDS of Algerian women and children blocked Paris yesterday to take part in a demonstration in the heart of the French capital. But police ringed the city and arrested later that they had detained 513 women and 118 children. More were trying to escape from the suburbs.

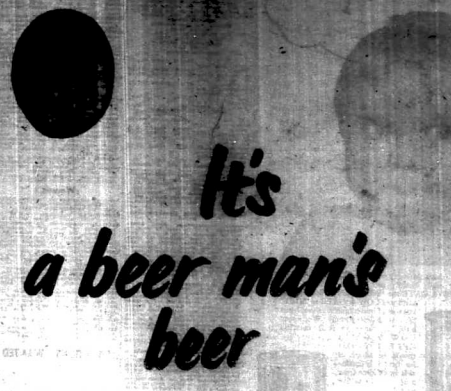

Scientists' reports start day of speculation

RUSSIA EXPLODES GIGANTIC BOMB

Twice as big as previous blasts

SCIENTISTS in Europe yesterday recorded a gigantic Arctic explosion, which many are believed to be Russia's threatened 50-megaton hydrogen bomb.

Sweden's Uppsala Observatory — the first to report the massive blast — said it took place in the Norway-Zemlya area, where other Soviet tests are taken place, and was more than double the previous biggest recorded there.

In America, however, the White House and the Atomic Energy Commission both expressed skepticism and Moscow said it had exploded the bomb.

Mr. Khrushchev announced at the Communist Party Congress in Moscow last week that the United States and Soviet nuclear tests would probably stop by October 29 or 31, probably with the explosion of 50-megaton nuclear bomb.

He also said Russia had a bomb of 100-megaton. "We would speak of it as though we might have it," he said. "We are not sure of it, but we are working on it." He said that the Soviet Union had a "very big" hydrogen bomb, which he said would be tested in the near future.

Convention warns: Put economy first

THE annual convention of the International Chamber of Commerce in London said today that the world's economic situation is "grave" and that "the only way to avoid a further deepening of the economic crisis is to put the economy first."

The convention, which is being held in London, is the largest gathering of business leaders from all over the world. It is expected to last for several days.

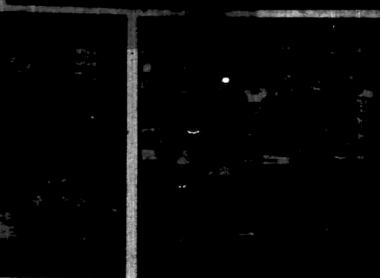

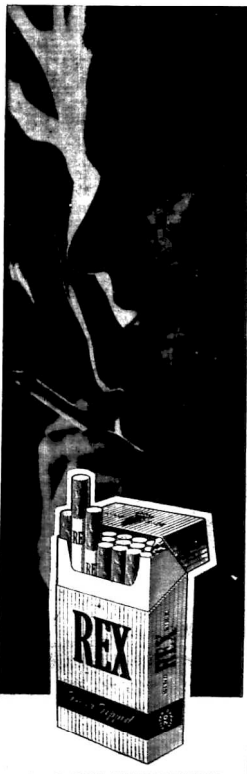

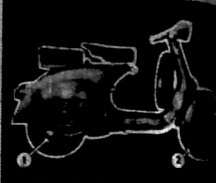

RECORD PAY-OUT TO PYRETHRUM CROWERS

PRODUCTION of dried pyrethrum flowers and the amount carried in the pyrethrum sales during the year ended June 30, 1961, were the highest in the history of pyrethrum growing in Ceylon. It is stated in the annual report of the Pyrethrum Board.

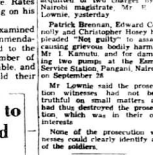

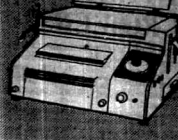

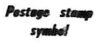
