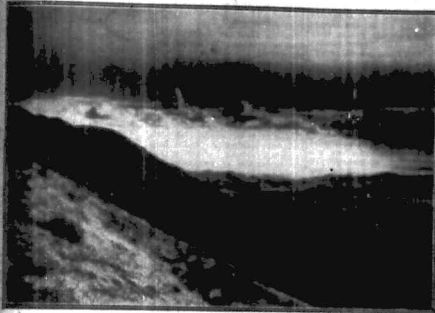

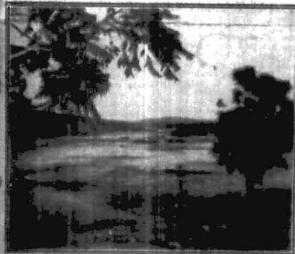

K. U. R. FIGURES FOR 1/2 YEAR

Increased Imports

Approximate traffic receipts of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours for the month of June were £211,156—£16,501 above the estimate, but £23,642 below the figure for June last year.

The approximate receipts for the first six months of this year were £1,242,282, an increase of £113,644 on the estimate, but a decrease of £112,106 on the tallies for the corresponding period of 1938.

Tonnages of petroleum import continued to show a steady increase, but to upcountry destinations decreased. General merchandise increased. Cement, motor oils, hardware, iron and steel manufactures, tires, hardware, petrol and oil were all up (last year by 1,189 tons). Imports of crumpled iron and cotton cloth showed, however, slight drops.

Coffee, various grades, and sisal and wool were the export commodities for the month of June and were on the figures for June last year of 2,187 to 2,581 tons, against 2,187 to 2,581 tons, an increase of 401, 387 and 69 tons respectively, and wool being increased from 223 to 2,778 tons. Coffee, cotton seed and maize tonnage fell considerably, by 5,420, 8,163 and 12,857 tons respectively.

Total export traffic received at the Coast for the first six months of this year was 262,250 tons, a decrease of 908 tons over total port traffic receipts received by the Coast for the 1938 figures being 278,171 tons, but import traffic of 92,423 tons was an increase of 13,244 tons over the corresponding period of last year, totalling 1,479,242, a decrease of 4,812 per cent.

Trumpeter's Mystery Death

"On the evidence I have heard I have come to the conclusion that deceased died as the result of some unknown disease administered to him by one Ibrahim who was the doctor referred to by the Resident Magistrate (Mr. Coffey) yesterday in connection with the Resident Magistrate's (Mr. John) on March 22, 1939, at Nairobi, who died of the same disease."

But two weeks later a report was received at the Police Station that a Native was lying wounded in River road, Nairobi. He was taken to hospital and on the way with his wife and family he died if he were killed. He also stated that the doctor who administered the medicine to him was Ibrahim, at Pumani. He died about two hours later.

Earlier evidence showed that while the man's death was consistent with poisoning probably due to something in the nature of strychnine, organs contained nothing to suggest poisoning.
