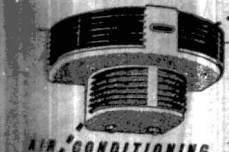

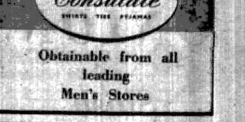

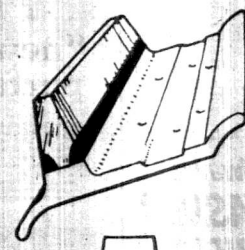

Plan aims at ten-acre units

NATIONAL INCOME RISE BY £45,000,000 YEARLY

If the aims of the Swynnerton Plan are achieved, the Colony's national income will be increased by £45,000,000 a year, the Minister for Finance, Mr. Vasey, told Kenya Legislative Council. The main principle of the plan was to increase the number of farming units of approximately ten acres a family and to increase the production of cash sales from £10 to £150 a year for providing for their own needs. This was the first occasion at which the Swynnerton Plan had been debated in the House. The debate was on a proposal by the Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Cresswell, that the House should constitute itself a committee of inquiry into the progress of the plan.

Members on both sides of the House were in favour of the plan. The Minister for Finance, Mr. Vasey, said that the plan was a revolutionary one and that it was a great step forward. OSA ATTACK MEANS WAR WITH U.S.

JAILED 'SPIES'; NAVAL BLOCKADE CONSIDERED

If China attacks Formosa, a state of war exists with the mainland of China and a counter-attack against the mainland is stated yesterday by the Secretary of State, Mr. Dulles.

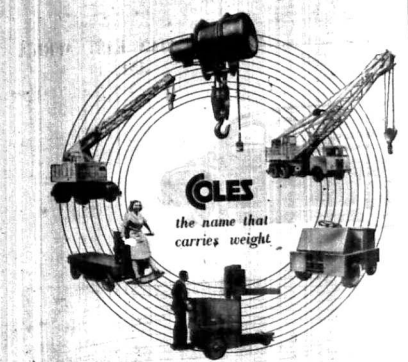

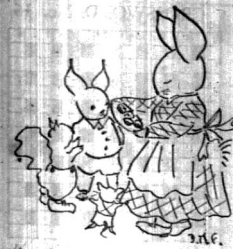
