'Attractive' surrender terms urged

MINISTER REPLIES TO SOCIALIST CRITICS

WHEN Socialist Members in the House of Commons pressed for "more attractive surrender terms to induce the Mau Mau terrorists to give up their arms," the Colonial Secretary, Mr. Lennox-Boyd, replied that the Kenya Government wanted to bring the "terrible business to a close as soon as possible. They would accept any possibility constantly offered."

He, however, said surrender terms already published stated that terrorists who surrendered voluntarily would not be prosecuted for any part of the Mau Mau possession of arms and ammunition or for fighting with terrorists.

He said that the Kenya Government is ready to consider any suggestion for more attractive terms for Mau Mau fighters and is discussing with them how the terms should be altered.

Mr. Callaghan (Labour) said: "I am sure that the Government will be glad to consider any suggestion for more attractive terms."

STORMS IN TANGANYIKA

WINDS over Kenya and the eastern half of Tanganyika are north-easterly but over Uganda and the western half of Tanganyika they are variable and at times heavy showers or thunderstorms are becoming weather. 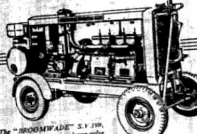
