A SOVIET Secret Police captain with orders to assassinate an American Communist in Frankfurt with poison bullets has been returned to the West.

He also gave American security officers exact details about changes in the Soviet Union since the death of Stalin and the execution of Lavrenti Beria, former Minister of the Interior.

The American High Commission in Bonn produced the captured Petrov at a press conference in Bonn yesterday.

Mr. Petrov, who was also assigned to the assassination of the United States High Commission while intelligence cameras and radio microphones recorded the proceedings.

### Points checked

A High Commission official, Mr. J. Macdonald, said the evidence had been the subject of worldwide investigations by U.S. security officers.

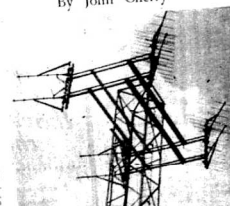

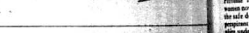

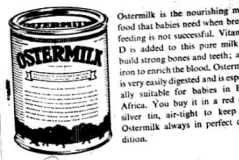

## 13,000 AFRICANS DETAINED IN SWEEP

### Batches go by rail to special camps PRAISE FOR K.P.R. WORK

WHEN the first stages of Operation Anvil, the joint military-police-administration plan to re-establish law and order in Nairobi, were completed by noon yesterday, the Kikuyu, Embu and Meru population of the city had been reduced by 13,000.

In operations in Punwani, Bahati and the Grogan Road areas, 7,500 men were detained. ANVIL was stopped and arrested by cordons outside the city. Before "Anvil" began 3,800 Mau Mau supporters were picked up by the police. Over the weekend 1,700 women and their children were repatriated by train and lorry to Reserves in the Central Province.

Operations in the city will go on until law and order is re-established. "The troops will stay here and the reserves will remain around Nairobi," a spokesman from G.H.Q., East Africa, stated yesterday.

No resistance was shown at Kikuyu, Embu and Meru was offered to the troops and police over the weekend. It was stated officially that the overall plan was proceeding smoothly and a considerable degree of success had been achieved.

Operations began at 4.59 a.m. on Saturday, when troops of the Buffs, Royal Northumberland Fusiliers, Royal West Kent Regiment, Black Watch, Kenya Rifles, and the 4th Bn. of the S.A.M. moved in to surround Punwani and Bahati.

They were backed by the K.A.F. police and police reservists, Kikuyu Guards and staff of G.H.Q. A specially equipped anti-aircraft battery of the coast guard, the City, Embu and Meru were taken to ensure security for the operation. It was stated yesterday that they had worked "tolerably well."
