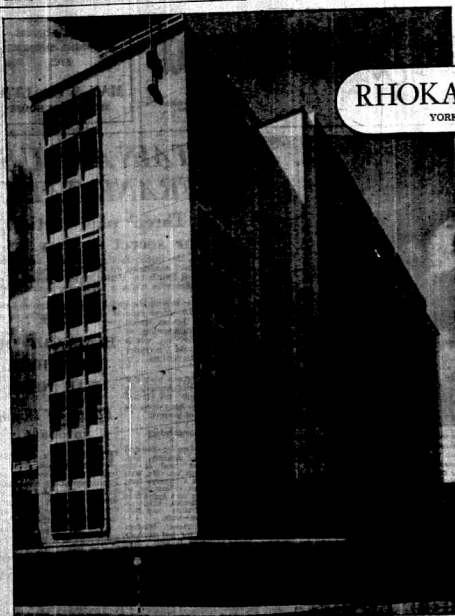

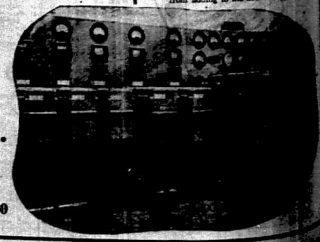

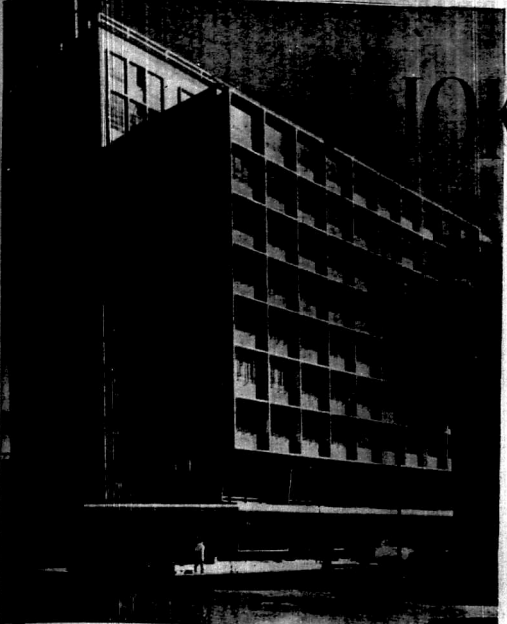

RHOKATAN HOUSE

THE City of Nairobi has risen to its greatest heights in the most difficult period of its history. An expression of this achievement is the number of substantial buildings which have lifted the face of the City during the last year, buildings representing great ability in design and great confidence in investment.

The tallest and most impressive is Rhokatan House, which was opened by the Mayor of Nairobi in January this year. It was built for Rhokatan Properties Limited, whose activities and associates are described on page 3.

Rhokatan House was designed around a condition common to the city area of Nairobi—small, expensive and frequently awkwardly shaped plots, which must be developed economically. This particular site is approximately 7,500 square feet and under the present by-law development to a height of 100 feet was allowed.

The Architects, Mr. Idris Davies and his assistant, Mr. Graham McCullough, were commissioned to design a building making the maximum use of the space available, under the governing conditions of the by-law: a ten-storey building was agreed upon, eight floors of Offices and two floors of Shops.

PLANNING

A coverage of 80 per cent of the total ground area was permitted for the two floors of Shops and 60 per cent for the Office floors. The majority of the Shops are "double-decker," having a ground and first floor with individual internal stairways. Each Shop was specially designed internally to meet the wishes and requirements of the tenants, all of whom had reserved their accommodation before building work was begun, in November 1932.

The Shops are perhaps the part of the Rhokatan House which have attracted most public interest. They have show windows on each floor from floor to ceiling, with armour-plated doors throughout the ground floor: the ground floor has five windows designed as refuge forced concrete boxes, open at the back for display purposes, and all set behind the building line, because of the otherwise narrow pavement in York Street.

The shop fronts, armour-plated doors and the main entrance doors were supplied and erected by Frederick Sage & Company (S.A.) Pty. Ltd., whose expert staff was specially flown to Nairobi for this contract.

Each floor of Offices is self-contained, having its own reception entrance, lift service, tea-room, strong-room and lavatories.

CONSTRUCTION AND FINISH

In keeping with contemporary practice, Rhokatan House consists of a reinforced concrete frame with panel infilling of lightweight punnic blocks, supplied by Daclen Limited, Nairobi. Externally the supporting surfaces above, stone columns in reconstructed stone, relieved with fins and awnings in white stucco.

The same treatment of black terrazzo has been used in the construction of the main stairways and main floor and walls. The Office floors throughout the building have been finished in cork tiles supplied by the Swedish firm of A/S Sano: the appearance of this floor finish is very striking and has the great advantage of

reducing considerably all sound throughout the building.

COLOUR

The owners were keen that the distinctive design of the building should be continued in the internal colour scheme. Light blue-grey was chosen as the main colour after a series of experiments, with doors in dark blue in the corridors. Other colours have been used in a manner which has not previously been seen in East Africa—boldly and yet with discretion. This part of the contract was carried out by Grafmann Limited.

Wrought-iron gates, manufactured in Nairobi, finished in black and outlined in gold leaf, make a striking entrance to each floor of Offices. The entrance on most floors has been designed as a reception area, to the particular requirements of individual tenants. The magnificent suite of Offices equipped by the East African Tobacco Company is entered through a reception hall, richly panelled and carpeted. African Explosives and Chemical Industries Ltd. have a reception area finished in the well-known decorative products of that Company. Rhokatan Investments (Kenya) Limited have a striking reception hall furnished to the owners' design by Hutchings, Biemer, Limited.

To ensure both a high standard of finish and uniformity the owners have provided nearly all the internal and external name signs—the internal lettering was designed and manufactured specially by The Lettering Centre in London, and consists of red and white plastic letters, and the Shop names, made in Nairobi by Averbos Limited, have been carved from four-inch blocks of wood.

Wood has been used with great effect throughout the building: an example is the use of muntzjir pillars and showcases in the premises of the Scandinavian Air-line System, which also has a large illuminated map of the world on the wall of its main office. Similar use of finely grained East African wood is seen in the Burroughs Department of The Anglo-Bank Corporation Limited.

SERVICES

A notable feature of Rhokatan House is the absence of any visible pipes and wiring either outside or inside the building. The Architects have achieved this in the case of piping by incorporating a large vertical services duct, adjacent to and part of the lift well. Horizontal plumbing is ducted under the floors, with access from continuous and accessible ducts for telephone and bell-wiring, allowing simple alterations at any time. Each floor has its own meter room and its own separate electrical distribution, all installed by Hartley Electromotives Limited.

Water is supplied to the building from four 500-gallon storage tanks on the roof: these tanks have been concealed to avoid the all-too-familiar eyesore seen on top of so many of our buildings. The contractors were Thornton & Turpin Limited.

Two Wapco-Chis lifts, travelling silently and thoroughly at great speed, carry the hundreds of visitors to Rhokatan House, and from the Office floors, an emergency electricity supply has been provided for use in the case of power cuts, rare though these cuts now seem to be. Security at night is provided by portable metal gates which may be locked in front of the lift entrance on the Office floors.

The contract figure for the main construction was £135,000. Additional costs, mainly in interior fittings, amounted to approximately £38,000. It is this combination of confident and far-seeing investors, able architects and experienced contractors, which will make the buildings of Nairobi equal at least to those of other cities of the world, a confidence which, in its widest sense, will contribute in great measure to a settled and prosperous Colony.

FIFTH COLUMN AT LEGAL AUSTRIAN

Diplomats' pressure to recruit spies

PETROV DISCLOSURES AT ROYAL COMMISSION

RUSSIA planned to set up a fifth column organisation in Australia ready for any future war, it was alleged at the opening in Canberra of the Royal Commission on espionage. Documents handed over by Mr. Vladimir Petrov, the former Soviet secret police chief, disclosed "W. V. W."

The chief Commonwealth counsel, Mr. G. V. Windygar, said that Mr. Petrov was granted political asylum last month, had been ordered to organise the fifth column organisation. Russia also hoped to bring in foreign agents, but that was foiled by security officers.

Soviet diplomats using blackmail and other pressure to recruit spies among junior civil servants, intellectual converts, secretaries, clerks and journalists. Mr. Petrov had stated that it was never found easy to recruit "really active and reliable" helpers in Australia.

Mr. Windygar added that although Mr. Petrov was officially the Secretary at the Embassy, he reported on other members of the staff to secret police H.Q. in Moscow direct and not through the Ambassador. His duties included investigating the activities of anti-Soviet organisations in Australia.

Mr. Petrov had stated that he was a Berlin man and his loyalty appeared to be with the Third Reich. Like-minded people in the secret police for some time as a result of the execution last year of Lavrenti Beria, the former head of the secret police. Mr. Petrov was active in 1951 was almost at a standstill and Mr. Petrov was reported for what was described as bad staff duties.

The hearing was adjourned until today.

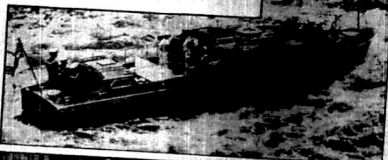
