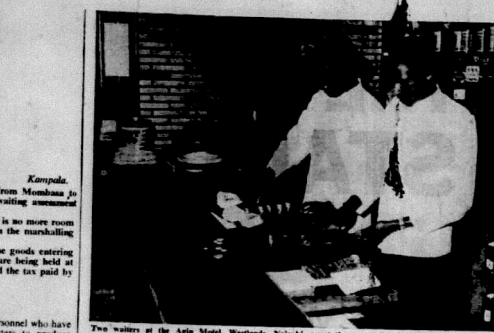

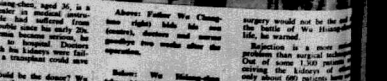

Speaking at the Commission of Enquiry on Deafness in Nairobi yesterday, Mr. Peter Clifford said there were three causes of deafness in Africa, which also hindered the progress of the continent — malnutrition, poor hygiene and lack of medical attention.

Malnutrition was the biggest problem. It caused diseases in growing children and adults. An excess of iron in the diet caused deficiency of vitamins, which developed into deafness.

Poor hygiene also caused disease. African mothers were not aware what their children ate, or even how the food was prepared. This led to diseases such as leprosy and trachoma.

Deafness, coupled with poverty, was a most major problem. Deafness believed that many children were deaf and they were not aware that their parents did not realize it and did nothing for it.

Asked what could be done to help eliminate these problems, Mr. Clifford said the problems were world-wide. In Africa there were some big hospital and food grants, and children would be helped if taken for treatment.


