For the past few days the news from the Czech capital, Prague, has not made headlines. The disquiet with which the new régime has been viewed since it ousted the former Communist leader, Mr. Novotny, has grown steadily in the past few months. Now Communist leaders, long familiar with heavy political pressure being brought to bear on them, are beginning to trend towards "liberalisation" and the "softening" of the régime. Despite official denials, the pressure is a deepening familiarity. If foreign troops continue to prevent a sovereign country striving to free itself from the Kremlin ideological line — as supposedly suggested in this page today — Europe's political clock will have turned back a long way.

The trend towards less rigid central control of press and other free trade policies is not confined to Czechoslovakia. It has been spreading slowly throughout Eastern Europe, including the Soviet Union, since the death of Stalin and the pace has quickened noticeably in the past year or two.

The victory of Mr. Dubcek and his colleagues within the Czech Communist Party has a highly popular one among the Czechs, and moves made so far to greater economic, intellectual and religious freedom have been enthusiastically welcomed.

Communism. A statement issued by the new régime in Prague yesterday emphasised that the experiments being made by the new régime are "dynamically revolutionary" and "a different and deeper scope of democracy, a socialist democracy."

A 130-strong force of North Vietnamese soldiers slipped through an American armoured cordon after a three-hour battle in the central highlands of South Vietnam, a U.S. military spokesman said in Saigon yesterday.

American helicopters transported the North Vietnamese force at noon on Monday, set up blocking positions and attacked.

After a three-hour fight the North Vietnamese slipped through the American lines leaving 17 dead behind them. The American lost four men wounded.

Another cordon was set up around a town in seven miles from the former imperial capital of Hue in the north of the country.

By Monday night the guerrillas had lost 15 men dead. Casualties of the American and South Vietnamese units were not yet known.

American jets in raids over North Vietnam destroyed some 100 enemy supply boats and a radar van.

Yielding to the bombardment of a Government infantry division, South Vietnamese military spokesmen said 15 men died. The bodies of the bombardment did not cause any casualties.

Between 45 and 50 helicopters equipped with 27,000-30,000 lbs of bombs were used in the South Vietnam's two northern provinces since the start of the military operation.

The number does not include support troops in progress. But after weeks of action against American

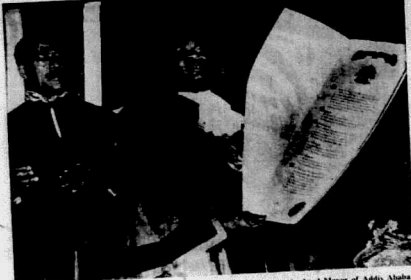

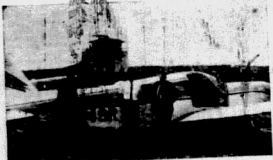

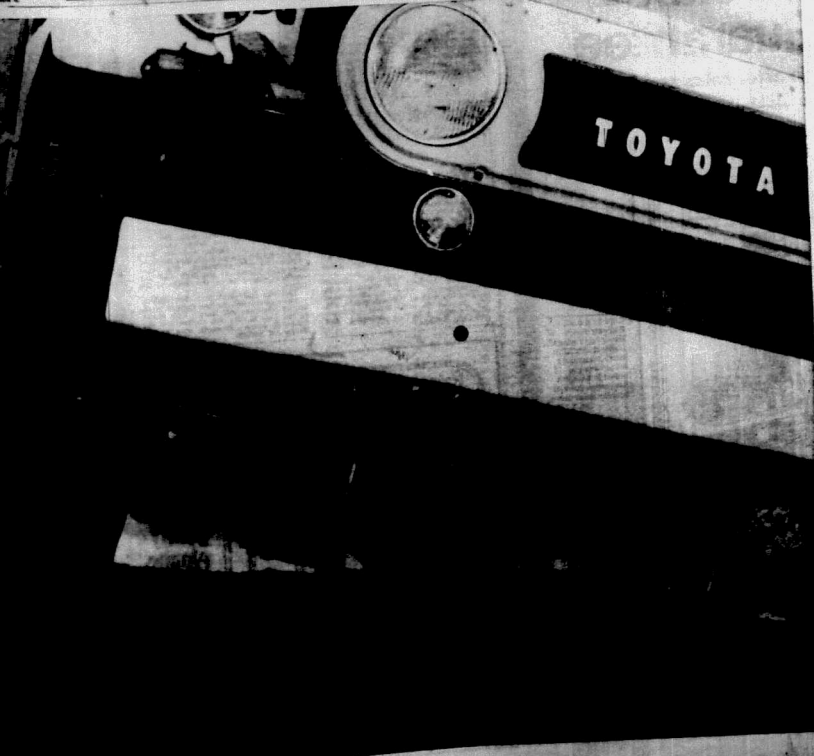

Her looks are very English, with fair hair slicked up on one side and blue eyes vividly emphasized. She knows how to wear clothes that attract; making her stand out in a crowd. She has had striking looks she hardly needs to be talked into.

Mrs. King became a make-up consultant for Elizabeth Arden at the age of 28 after having been employed by the firm as a beautician while she was in Manila. Her husband, having her first face treatment.

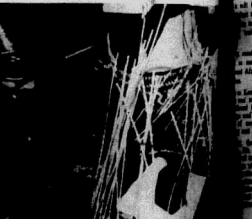

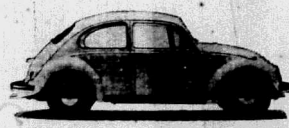

Statistics for 1967-68 flat season

The flat racing statistics for the Kenya 1967-68 season tell their story in much greater detail than words could ever do but there are a few points worthy of mention, namely the number of races and the level of prize money.

It is a fact not generally known that there has been much less racing in the 1967-68 season than in either of the two previous ones. There were only 187 races under Jockey Club rules in the season just ended as compared with 218 in 1965-66 and 229 in 1965-66. This has resulted in larger fields and is not very welcome to one who has to make a living out of the horses.

The winning prize money for the season totalled £12,588 which is against £10,662 in 1966-67. However the average per race was £116 this season as against £156 in the previous one.

Scenes of wild Kanu jubilation as riot police stand by

All 40 Kenya People's Union nominees for municipal elections in Nairobi were disqualified yesterday by the Nairobi District Commissioner, Mr. W. K. Martin.

Shouting above uproar in the council chamber of City Hall, Mr. Martin declared all K.P.U. candidates barred because their papers were not in order and that all Kanu council members were disqualified.

The announcement came as the climax to a day of political tension in Nairobi during which the office of the K.P.U. became a virtual fortress against an attack by Kanu youth-leaders. In the incident a riot driver was taken to hospital and the Nairobi Kanu organising secretary, Mr. Summy Mwaigi, was said to have been punched.

Dozen examples given

Later in the morning steel-helmeted riot police stood between groups of K.P.U. and Kanu supporters in Sgt. Ellis Avenue and were called in at one point to break up an incident which threatened to erupt into serious disturbance.

The lists of candidates of both parties were scheduled to be announced at noon in the council chamber by the D.C. Shortly before then a number of Kanu leaders entered the council chamber and good quietly with hushed officials as Mr. Martin prepared to speak.

The Encyclical letter admitted that this method was unreliable, Prof. Casati said.

The Pope yesterday answered critics all over the world of his first ban on artificial birth control and hinted that he might publish another Papal document covering all the problems of matrimony and family life.

He said the document was not merely the statement of a negative law, but a positive guide to original morality.

The Pope said the knowledge of his great responsibility had caused him no small suffering.

Yesterday was the third day of the summit, conducted against a background of threatening Soviet troop movements inside Czechoslovakia and its neighbouring Communist territories. There was no word news from either side on how the talks were progressing.

Earlier in the evening, after news of the Soviet army leader's illness, Czechoslovak news sources said the talks were over.

But one newspaper editor said talks had continued at least a couple of more hours. "They were probably just a possibility, they will remain."

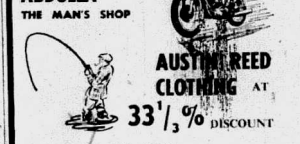

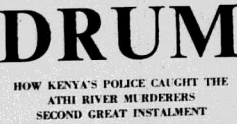
