As Russian troops tighten their grip on Czechoslovakia last night, Members of the Czech National Assembly denounced the invasion of their country by five members of the Communist Party and demanded the release of their popularly elected leaders. They also appealed to world Parliaments and public opinion for support.

Lands and troops of Russia, Poland, Hungary, Bulgaria and the armies of Czechoslovakia were in the hands of the invaders. They within hours were in Prague, where key points were occupied.

## WORLD SHAKEN BY SOVIET MOVE

World reaction yesterday to the invasion of Czechoslovakia was one of shock and disapproval of the Soviet move.

Authoritative circles in London considered that the Soviet military intervention would deliver a harsh blow to the development of relations between East and West. Diplomatic circles wondered whether the Foreign Secretary, Mr. Bevin, would go on with his planned visit to Switzerland, to Hungary, Bulgaria and Romania.

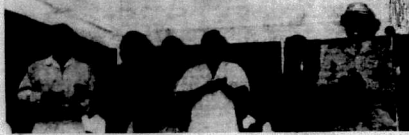

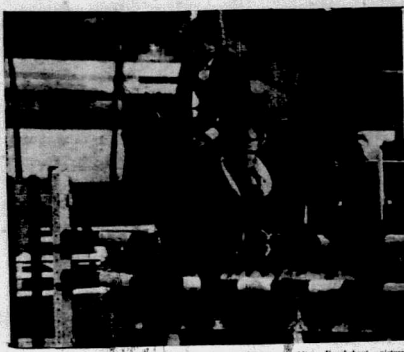

# Rising toll of the roads

Still the death toll rises in Kenya's roads. Bloodied in the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia will probably be exceeded the casualty lists for the past three months of those who have been killed on the roads in this country.

Each week at least 19 people were killed. Here a stark reminder of the warning that has been issued and the need to be recommended.

In countries where breathalysers have been introduced in the determination to stop motorists drinking excessively, there has been immediate outbreaks of public opinion, rumbling against governmental "spoil sports" and legislation which tends to change the pattern of social life.

Motorists can decide for themselves. No reasonable Government, least of all Kenya's, which understands the contribution of good fellowship from the enjoyment of life, wishes to damp down the people's spirits. But enough is enough. The trouble is that some people do not know when to stop.

Motorists can have a drink or two and remain sober, and the law-makers have no cause for interference. Or they can proceed drunk, drive to the peril of other people, and the closing of the hated breathalyser is inevitable.

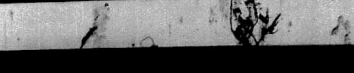

# Government working for people says Minister

## CONTROLS URGED ON 'TEMBO' BREWING

The Government should change the system governing the issue of licences to brew, under the terms of the East African Beers Association (Kenya branch), Dr. H. H. Hlobani, said in a statement to the East African Standard yesterday.

He was commenting on a report of a recent visit by the Executive Commissioner, Mr. F. M. Mbabhe, who said that cases of bottled beer a month were being drunk at Mombasa District, and warned of measures to curb illegal beer brewing.

In a point of fact in the last six months the average consumption of excised bottled beer in the district amounts to slightly over 100 cases per month, and Mr. Hlobani's statement "Further more, the increase in consumption of bottled beer in Mombasa District over the last three years is from 5,500 cases to 7,500 cases.

"The increase in below the average for Kenya on the whole for the period in question and is a particularly notable increase in the context of an area which has benefited more than the average from the increased production and sale of cash crops and produce.

"Some countries have noted the increase in drinkmaking at Mombasa District, but please let it be fairly stated that this is not due to excess

production of alcohol, which is caused by the vast increase in the number of people, but by the fact that the Government has not taken any steps to curb the production of alcohol.

While the Government had committed itself to having the legal standards of the bottles and the bottles themselves must take the initiative in helping the Government.

The Assistant Minister, who is going on leave pending transfer to the M.P. for Mombasa, said that several projects in the Mombasa area were being undertaken to improve the living standards of the people.

Mr. Karuki was given three bottles which were presented to him by the Executive Commissioner, Mr. Eliud Nguni, for the Mombasa Agricultural Centre.

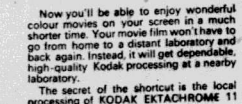

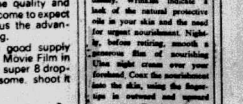

# P.C. tells abusive youths to quit Kisumu

Standard Correspondent, Kisumu.

The Nyanza P.C. Mr. Charles Murgor, has told youths who abuse or attack citizens of Kisumu to leave the town.

He said members of both political party-youth wings who were roaming about the streets abusing or attacking citizens, especially those in positions of respect, should go back to their respective home areas, where they could participate fully in the task of nation-building.

The P.C. said he had heard of youths who were misbehaving in the town, but none of them had gone so far as to display disrespect to Government people, elders, M.P.s and other citizens.

"This sort of behaviour, he said, is contrary to African traditions and even to Christianity. He said youths are expected to set a good example by showing respect to elders and other citizens in

respectable positions. The authorities can not tolerate this kind of behaviour any more."

Mr. Murgor criticised a recent incident in which an M.P. was involved in the street. The incident almost led to a breach of the peace and did in fact lead to another incident when fighting broke out at the Kaimosi office in the town, during which a member of the Kisumu Municipal Council was assaulted and had his shirt torn into pieces.

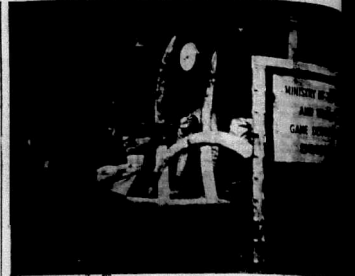
M.P.s, irrespective of their political parties or affiliations, were respected citizens who were making the laws of the land, and anybody who abused them in public was committing an offence which was punishable, Mr. Murgor said.

The P.C. went on to say that youths who were party to such incidents should play their part in the building of nation-building, and should not allow themselves to be brought into disrepute by cowardly politicians who were making money out of the situation.

### Government anxious over Chemilil factory

The Government was determined to see that the Chemilil sugar factory was fully operating as soon as possible, so that the large amount of overgrown sugar cane in the sugar-growing areas of Nyanza Province was processed without further delay. An Assistant Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Kariki, said when he visited the area.

Mr. Kariki, who was accompanied by the Nyanza P.C. Mr. C. Murgor, an assistant secretary in his Ministry, Mr. Kiprono Bodi, and the Provincial Agricultural Officer, Mr. M. G. Saito, had earlier discussed with the management the problems of the factory and the factors which had brought about its existing low production.

The Assistant Minister was told by the managing agent of the (Chemilil) company, Mr. Peter D. Young, that the factory was at the moment producing between 70 and 800 tons of cane a day and, when in full production, was capable of handling 2,700 tons of cane.

After a tour of the factory, Mr. Kariki told the Government engineers and experts who were running the factory that the Government was anxious to see the state of the factory corrected. He wanted further delay and that it would take steps to ensure that machinery was brought to the factory.

Mr. Kariki stated the Government would like to see the factory in full production in the shortest possible time.

### FARM OFFICERS TOUR AUSTRALIA

Two agricultural officers from Kenya have left for Australia for a three-month study tour. They are Mr. J. K. Njeru and Mr. Simon K. Wanjohi, District Agricultural Officers for Nyeri and Kisii.
