RUSSIA WANTED: NATO CANNOT BE BEATEN

Spaak claim in reply to Soviet charges AID FOR TURKEY

AS the United Nations General Assembly was last night to resume its adjourned debate on Syria's allegations of "immense aggression" against her, Turkey, delegates were considering the impact of a declaration by the Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation, M. Spaak, that the West would aid Turkey if she were attacked.

This speech was seen as an answer in the same code to Russia, which has been issuing repeated warnings that if Syria were attacked Russia would offer her military assistance. M. Spaak added that it was impossible for Russia to wage a successful war against NATO.

Baghdad Pact upheld

Further, though indirect, support for Turkey yesterday came from Persia and Iraq two of her associates in the Baghdad Pact for the defence of the Middle East. They pledged themselves to uphold the Pact and to take responsible measures to uphold that of Syria's independence. Reports from Damascus that King Saud of Saudi Arabia had withdrawn his application offer at Syria's independence were also discussed by United Nations observers. The Arab News Agency stated that Baghdad Minister, Mr. Fakhri, had arrived in Damascus on a private visit.

'No immediate sign of hostilities'

SYRIA yesterday signed an agreement with the United States for financial and technical aid which will make her a member of the 22 year-old Interim. Interest is believed to be high.
