

NEW CONSTITUTIONAL PLAN FOR KENYA

12 selected seats under electoral college system MORE AFRICAN MEMBERS

WITHIN a few hours of the resignation of the five Elected Members, the Colonial Secretary, Mr. Lennox-Boyd, yesterday announced details of new constitutional arrangements in Kenya which replace the Lyttelton Plan of 1954.

At a meeting at Government House, Mr. Lennox-Boyd told Unofficial Members that the resignations had made the Constitution unworkable and that the British Government was therefore, free to take such action as it and anxieties of the people of Kenya as a whole.

Protection of communities The Colonial Secretary has decided — he said his intention were "clear and definite" — that there will be a Council of State with powers of delay, revision and reference to protect any one community against discriminatory legislation harmful to its interests. The six additional Africans will be determined later.

Posts of Assistant Minister The Executive and Admin. Ministers without Portfolio will be given added responsibilities without the need for extra Ministers. The size of the Council of Ministers remains an open question.

CONCERN OVER QUALITY OF WHEAT IN KENYA

NEED FOR IMPORTS

GOOD quality wheat flour is no longer being produced in Kenya, it has been found. The Government has been advised by a team of experts from the United Kingdom that the wheat produced in Kenya is of such poor quality that it is not fit for human consumption. 





OCTOBER 'ALERT'

SINCE October 1 American planes in Europe, the Mediterranean and on the North African coast have been standing by the edge of runways, loaded with hydrogen bombs, and ready to take off in less than 15 minutes.

This was revealed by the commander of the United States Strategic Air Command, Gen. Thomas S. Power, at a Press conference in Paris, where a conference of parliamentarians of the 13 member-nations of Nato is being held this week.

Gen. Power had been asked what effect the Soviet Sputnik and intercontinental ballistic missile would have on the deterrent power of the Atlantic alliance. He replied: "We are always on edge to ensure the enemy that he will not be able to launch his aggression and that defeat is inevitable."

Gen. Power gave details of his command's plans to move any aggression. He said on October 7 the United States Strategic Air Force was alerted to the total and we intend to increase this until one-third of the total force is on alert.

"This means that the total force will be 1500 B-52's and 1500 B-36's, fully equipped to meet any aggression."




