

## STUDIO THEATRE'S NEW PRODUCTION "Doctor in the House"

THE stage adaptation of Willard Gaynor's well-known medical guide to the medical profession, "Doctor in the House," got off to aむcking start at the Studio Theatre, Nairobi, on Tuesday, December 10, after the milk and water had been drunk by the players, owners, to appreciate the importance of a mid-holiday treat.


