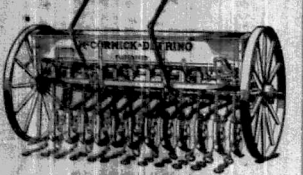

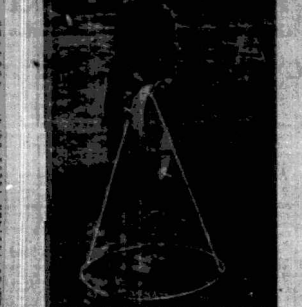

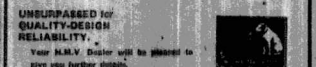

Conference plans control, preservation

(Standard Dar es Salaam Correspondent)

Game preserved in perpetuity in Tanganyika National Parks, regarded as vermin in closely settled areas, and some of man paramount—this is the picture contemplated by the Salaam and attended by representatives of the Administration, the Department of Agriculture, Forest, Game, Lands and Mines, Tsetse Research and Survey and Veterinary Departments, with industrial delegates from Tanganyika, Kenya and the London Parks Society under the chairmanship of Mr. R. W. R. Miller, Member for the Secretary and Natural Resources.

The conference was opened by the Acting Governor, Mr. E. R. E. Surrage, who said it had been called by the Game Department to deal with the problems of game control and preservation, and to take stock of the situation.

The Game Department, he said, had been working on for three years with staff and equipment inadequate in many parts of the territory or to hunt in the bush and the main pestancy from the dependence on the Government.

Unrivalled aspect
Government could no longer neglect the game, he said. It was of great value to the Empire as a source of raw materials and was agreed to hand over the responsibility to the Government in an organization more in keeping with the importance of the game.

The Executive welcomed Capt. G. Caldwell, executive officer of the Fauna Society, London, and Mr. R. W. R. Miller, Member for the Kenya National Parks. The Government was to be divided on the relationship of game to man, industry and agriculture. It was unanimously agreed that the needs of man must be regarded as paramount.

In the view of the unique nature of the game fauna of the territory it must be preserved for scientific and that this could only be achieved by the National Parks, and that in any closely settled area game control be regarded as vermin.

Five-mile buffers
In order to ensure an effective buffer between settlement and National Parks the Government should consider the possibility of a five-mile buffer zone around the Parks and that the boundaries of the Parks should be under the control of the Game Department of the Trustees of the Parks.

The conference held that the boundaries of the Serengeti National Park should be defined and that the Government should propose that other National Parks be similarly considered necessary for the preservation of the game fauna of the territory, including all the requirements of the game species of the locality, including the requirements of the game fauna in relation to their migration. The use of funds should be investigated and steps should be taken to demarcate all boundaries with the Department of National Parks, the present Game Reserve would not be needed in its entirety.

The conference was strongly of the opinion that it is undesirable for people and domestic livestock to be present in any National Park. It noted the presence in the Serengeti National Park of about 150,000 head of cattle and 150,000 head of small stock.

Policy for Masai
It was agreed that it is impracticable to remove the Masai and their stock from the Park and the Government policy should be to limit the number of Masai and their stock in the Park and to provide Government policy and steps must be taken to find alternative means and grazing facilities to enable them to be removed from the Park.

In reply to a question the chairman stated that the Masai had been made for the Park and the Government of the Protectorate of Tanganyika, and that the Government of Tanganyika had been specially appointed to investigate the demarcation of the Serengeti National Park.

The hunting of game in National Parks should be limited in general, recommended the conference, and the hunting of the hunter and his family to be limited to the sale of meat and trophies, which was agreed.

Game meat as food
Vermin control, it was unanimously agreed, must be regarded as an integral part of the game. The Game Department, which should be strengthened for the purpose, the first thing being the provision of a permanent force of rangers and provisors. These officers themselves should be responsible for the destruction of the larger game which was required to be controlled by the Native authorities in the control and destruction of the other vermin by the people.

There is no only control of the conference, that vermin control should remain the responsibility of the Government and every step should be taken to make the Native authorities realize that this work is the responsibility of the people themselves.

Value of ivory
The conference to meet for Mr. H. Moore, V.C.J. explained the proposal, which had been accepted by the Government, that the Government would include two principal divisions of game control, one for the control and provision for two scientific purposes, and the other for the control of at least one officer with appropriate scientific qualifications to be appointed as soon as possible.

LIGHTENING AFRICA'S 'DARKNESS'

Plan for 'Science High Command'

THE first step in a Pan-African campaign to lighten Africa's 'darkness' will be taken at the University of the Witwatersrand in Johannesburg in October when about 100 scientists, representing United Nations bodies, three major Powers and more than 25 Territories and more than the United Government will co-ordinate science and research front to tackle diseases attacking Africa and plan to set up a High Command for the continent which will be organized on an international scale to coordinate the continent's scientific efforts as it is the start of an era of scientific progress in Africa. It will be opened by the Prime Minister, Dr. D. J. M. K. on October 17, and will last 12 days.

Long-term research

The provisional agenda for the conference stresses the need for special facilities for long-term research. This includes the early movement of research workers to the territory to observe, exchange of information, exchange of ideas, and the holding of conferences and the setting-up of special research organizations with exchange of research workers between different countries.

The first priority section will be research Africa's existing facilities, research and scientific work. Committees will then study the need for physical environment, which will include the need for special subjects and maps, meteorology and weather records for various areas, and the study of climate in relation to land use.

Soils and plants, including timber and medicinal plants, and plant nutrition. Zoology, including game control, animal husbandry, and marine and freshwater fish. Health and social research, under racial and tribal studies of Native, Indian and population of Native, and study of climate in relation to land use.

Technology, including housing in hot climates, roads and motor vehicles, the search, the use of raw materials for the chemical industry, and the development of new crops for industrial purposes.

The emphasis will be on Africa's potentiality for attracting a much larger, healthier and more progressive population. It will include the setting-up on a grand scale to supply food and materials for the rest of the world.

Consultations between the Governments involved in the scientific laboratory will follow. The final conference will be held in Johannesburg with the participation of the United Nations High Command to organize and coordinate the continent's scientific efforts. French and Portuguese Colonies, the Trust Territories, and the States of the governing States such as the Union and Southern Rhodesia.

South Africa, as the highest developed country south of the Sahara will play a part in the proposed research. The Union will not send any research workers. The Government of Botswana will be responsible for the main organization. For this conference, Mr. P. B. J. Schabane, President of the South African Council for Scientific and Industrial Research, and Dr. F. J. van der Merwe, Director-General of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, will be the main organizers.

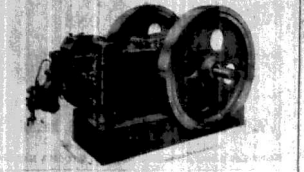

KENYA ELECTORS' UNION CONFERENCE

Need stressed for agricultural policy for African areas

A RESOLUTION that the conference urges Government to lay down an agricultural policy for the African areas, and to introduce such measures as are necessary to carry it out, was passed at the tenth annual conference of the Electors' Union in the Memorial Hall, Nairobi, by Mr. S. Howitt.

Mr. Howitt declared that it was urgent that something be done in the African areas. Citing the Mau Mau Reserve, he said there were 170,000 head of cattle on 17,000 acres. In the course of the next two years a further 50,000 cattle in the Mau Mau Reserve had to be removed.

"For that reason," he said, "we demand compulsory de-stocking."

Mr. Wilkinson, who presided, said that the mover had spoken as an agriculturist to the meeting. With special reference to the Mau Mau Reserve, he said that the Government should take steps to train the younger generation of Africans in such matters as stock raising.

Tribute to Nandi

Mr. L. E. H. Wainwright, elected chairman for the year, presented the motion but gave warning of what compensation established in the Mau Mau Reserve and quite large numbers of people.

The number of cattle to be returned to the Mau Mau Reserve was estimated at 25,000 head, and a further 20,000 from Somalia and other areas. He said that it would be a "terrible" loss to the Nandi people if the Government were to take the cattle out of the area.

Major Hildreth pointed out that since 1952, when Sir Daniel Halliday was Governor, the Nandi people had been working on the Mau Mau Reserve. He said that the Government should take steps to train the younger generation of Africans in such matters as stock raising.
