WRESTLING WITH STRANGE NEW PROBLEMS.

WORLD CONFERENCE KEYNOTE SET BY "GLOOM RAISER" COCKTAIL.

London is registered as most impetuous to use the word "friction" in the South Kensington Geological Museum where the delegates of 46 nations have gathered for the World Economic Conference.

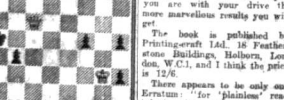

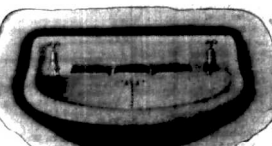

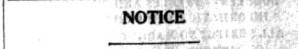

EXPORTS OF NATIVE ORIGIN IMPROVED BY £50,000 TO £262,000.

Although during 1932 Kenya lost five occupiers of land compared with the total of 2,107 recorded in 1931, the area under occupation by white settlers increased during the year by over 7,000 acres.
