END OF THE MOSCOW DRAMA.

Sentences Passed On British Engineers.

TWO TO SERVE TERMS OF IMPRISONMENT. Three Deported: One Acquitted.

STRANGE EARLY MORNING SCENES WHILE MEN AWAIT THEIR FATE.

At five minutes to one yesterday morning in the midst of a death-like silence the President of the Moscow Court passed sentence upon British and Russian accused at the close of the most sensational trial of modern times.

The sentences on the English engineers were—

- THORNTON: Three years.
McDONALD: Two years.
MONKHOUSE: Expulsion.
CUSHNY: Expulsion.
NORDELL: Expulsion.
GREGORY: Acquitted.

Sentences ranging from 10 years to 15 months were passed on the Russian prisoners only.

Judge's Contention.

The President of the Court maintained that Thornton was the chief instigator of the crimes and that Monkhouse was concerned with him.

London spent an anxious night awaiting the result. At the Foreign Office high officials kept a direct telephone open to Moscow and the evening newspapers made special arrangements to issue extra editions after the normal publication hours.

A statement has been issued by Metropolitan Vickers reaffirming complete confidence in the members of the company's staff who have been the victims of a "black and white" justice. The statement criticises the evidence and the alleged confessions and promises a detailed examination as soon as legal advisers return from Moscow.

Privy Council Meets.

An announcement was made at an early hour yesterday that the Privy Council would meet later in the forenoon at Windsor Castle to authorise a Proclamation under the recent Act of Parliament intended to empower Government to prohibit or regulate importation of goods from Russia.

No Death Penalty.

It is the established British practice that the death penalty is not imposed in any case of industrial accident. The Russian Government, however, has insisted on a death sentence for Thornton and Monkhouse.





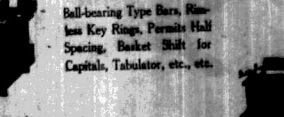

Striking Speech By Russian Prosecutor

MOSCOW FORECASTS OF THE SENTENCES.

No Death Penalties for Britons.

OPINION IMPRESSED BY BRITISH PARLIAMENT'S ACTION.

Well-informed circles in Moscow anticipate that the sentences in the sensational Russian trial are likely to be as follows:

- MacDonald and Thornton—10 years.
- Monckhouse—3 years.
- Cushny and Nordwell—released and bound over.
- Gregory—acquittal.
- Gusev and Lohansky—death.
- Other Russians—imprisonment.

The Public Prosecutor concluded a striking address, vigorously, even vehemently delivered, with the words: “We do not want blood and vengeance.”

British circles in Moscow regard the coincidence between the prosecution's moderate demands and the action of the British Parliament in deciding to employ Government to prohibit Russian imports as significant.

There is a possibility that the sentences on the British engineers may be commuted to exile.

The Prosecutor declared that the Russian Courts were proceeding against the exploitation of workers; English justice, on the other hand was directed against the poor.

“Never in any case,” he declared, “have we had such conclusive proof of guilt.”

Accquittal for Gregory Only?

Memorandum, Monday. When the Court re-assembled this morning for the trial of the five British engineers and eight Russian employees of the Metropolitan Vickers on charges of rape, seduction, adultery, and other offenses, two requests were made for the inclusion in the evidence of documents connected with the case. One request was for the production, for the testimony of the witness, of a letter from Alan Monckhouse, the defendant, to the Metropolitan Vickers, in which he stated that he had supplied the Metropolitan Vickers with the names of the British witnesses.

A Holiday Atmosphere.

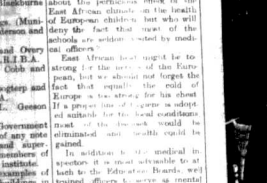

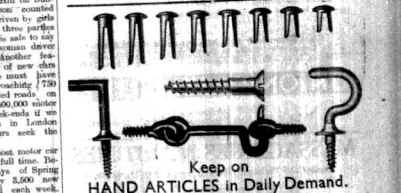

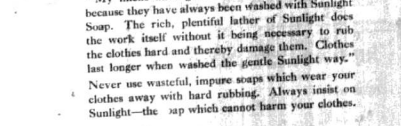
