DETENTION CAMPS

Anti-Communist moves in North-East

REGULATION permitting the detention of any person in the North-Eastern Region, if it is necessary for the preservation of public order, has been published in a Kenya Gazette Supplement. The Public Order (North-Eastern Region) (Detention Camps) Regulations, 1964 were issued by the Prime Minister, Mr. Kenyatta.

Power to issue detention orders rests with the Minister for Internal Security and the administration and inspection of detention camps will be the responsibility of the Minister for Home Affairs.

Under the regulations, the right of appeal against a detention order is allowed to the Appellate Tribunal appointed by the Minister for Internal Security and Detention.

Statement of grounds necessary

The original would consist of a chairman who holds a high judicial office in Kenya or elsewhere, one other who is or has been a magistrate empowered to hold subordinate courts of the first class in Kenya, and at least one other member.

Whenever a detention order is issued it must be accompanied by a statement in writing of the grounds on which the order has been made and of the fact that right of appeal is available.

The case of any detained person will be reviewed by the Appellate Tribunal at least once during every successive period of six months, and that review will be directed at ascertaining the removal or retention of the detention.

The regulations provide that the Minister for Home Affairs should establish a committee of inquiry, for the purpose of ascertaining the grounds on which a man and at least three other persons have been detained. The Minister would form the committee.

Every detention camp would be visited at least once every period of three months by a committee of inquiry.

The other charge of a detention order is the failure to attend to the duties of the person concerned or to keep his accounts up to date.

Parliamentary legislation was made public in October 6.

Maize schemes

... could be the salvation of Kenya's maize industry, the Kenya Maize Marketing Board, Mr. Paul Negi, said, in the Kenya Maize Improvement Centre Field Day yesterday.

The success of these new developments should be due time, not only bringing the production of maize to a level which would give the maize farmer a good profit by his production, but also increase crop exports covering the cost.

The industry has come through a very serious period of difficulties but the future which has studied the industry believe 1955 will be a year of general development. It is generally felt that the development of types of hybrid and synthetic maize plants giving greater yields than those of which could better resist weathers.

The Government has established a permanent maize board locally and overseas, for the quality of its maize from the best available sources, but with average yields of 10 to 12 bushels of eight bags per acre in the growing areas and about five bags in the best of the established areas. It is expected that the yield of the new maize will be about 30/ to 35/ per 200lb. net weight, about 100 bushels, at the mill.

OLD TYPE RARELY PROFITABLE

Even with export prices relatively high during the bumper surplus crop last year, the highest price back to the growers in Kitale was only 21/- per 200lb. net.

Very few means could grow the type of maize normally profitable in the current season, immediately following the 1954 season of a record crop and record exports, which was insufficient to meet the demand and the board had to buy considerable quantities of maize of quality in a 1/2 c from the Government.
