# Kenya unity 'attacked' by U.K. Press

## Stanleyville rebels

A Belgian-Chartered DC4 aircraft crashed on take-off at Stanleyville airport and conflicting reports put the death toll at variously between seven and 36, with no firm indication of how many were on board the plane.

Officials of the Belgian International Air Transport Service, which ran the crashed plane, said they were not sure if it was hit by rebel gunfire or if it crashed by accident.

People returning from Stanleyville on an earlier flight said they saw hundreds of rebels massed in dense bush at the far end of the runway and Camp Air Force planes were firing on the plane and on the air.

An airline company official said the crew and all 30 passengers of the estimated 40 Congolese passengers were killed. A U.S. Air Force source told reporters that only Belgian people were on the plane and that seven — four Belgian and three Congolese — were killed.

The Swedish charter line Transair told reporters an official had called the Stanleyville air tower. He said they had heard of a boy many were aboard the plane.






