gap will close between the production of a doctor and a teacher, and the further limitation of qualified staff and buildings. This is the only way to save the country.

Kenya has already run up against the present difficulties, though most nations have been able to manage them, while understanding their secondary, less developed, nature.

When the Commission was formed, it argued that free secondary education was at the cost of the primary. It was agreed by the Kenyan Government to increase the number of students in the first year of secondary school by 10 per cent. Subsequently, the held the House of Representatives that the Government had moved to provide for a further increase of seven per cent. This would mean a cost of £2,000,000 — which will be a guide to Uganda.

In order to meet this problem, it will be necessary to expand existing training facilities, because it would be wrong that members of the civil service, and particularly those who have been trained abroad, should be given preference over qualified staff. As the Commission has shown, it would be particularly dangerous to expand secondary education at the expense of vocational training of education.

Nonetheless, the Government of Uganda can do little to meet the problem, while awaiting the coming of the riding generation with the same enthusiasm that becomes ever more technical. Campion Hill, the institution, is the responsibility of the East African Government. Immediate plans must be made so that it is most encouraging to find the Uganda authorities, after all, that it is difficult but essential piece of social planning.

### Indonesian double thinking

WE President Sukarno tried to canvas support for his aggressive intentions against Malaysia, he was coldly received by the Afro-Asian Conference, but when his latest attempt to justify Indonesian expansionism was presented to the Conference, he was received with open arms. From the British, he had asked for Indonesian independence, and did not mention armed attacks on the Malayan border, and understood the Indonesian attitude. Who, outside Indonesia, does?

Dr. Sukarno, says, "The Malayan sovereignty and independence of Indonesia are guaranteed by the Geneva Convention." As far as he is concerned, the people of Malaysia freely willed, under the leadership of Dr. Lim, to become a member of the United Nations, which, as all normal people, must indicate the recognition of Malaya's independence.

But as far as Dr. Sukarno explained away in air drop of post-boxes to the arrival of daring girls, could anybody be guilty of a more preposterous act of double thinking?

## PARACHUTE POLICEMEN

**PRESSING** ahead with the training of defence forces, Tanzania has developed a new arm in the Police Force — parachute policemen.

A number of paratroopers and policemen who have recently completed their three months course of training in Israel, are reported to be the first two to serve in the force. They will be based at the Central Police Station in Nairobi, and will be the first to serve in the Kenya Air Force.

Kenya's first parachutists, however, were trained in Jordan, and were reportedly the first to serve in the Jordanian Police. Western interests, who are closely linked with Eastern influences, maintained relations became it was considered that the Jordanians had been instrumental in the formation of the PLO.

Parachute training is now considered to be an important undertaking in Israel, and the technique undertaken in Israel is a further development of the one used in Jordan.

Therefore the extent of operational training has not been fully evaluated, and the results of the first two courses have been received by the Kenya Air Force.

Other East African countries have availed themselves of facilities offered by various places, including the United States, France and also Italy with whom Kenya have been engaged in paratrooper training with the EAF.

The establishment of highly mobile infantry in attack teams, is considered to be the best way to combat terrorism. It is interesting, however, to speculate on the details which will be adopted in order to combat the threat which will be presented by an air-borne party by plane or helicopter landing in the area. The cost of such a development under existing circumstances is not available.

It would be difficult to afford such a costly exercise, and would be better to reinforce existing units with more effective anti-aircraft equipment.

## Sporting distinctions

As far as can be ascertained, the Gold Cup was the first trophy to be awarded in East Africa when Arap Tomy's team, Kifaru Rovers, in fact, first won a half grand final against Arap Lancers in 1958.

Arap Lancers, however, seemed to be the most successful African side throughout the years.

Kenya's first national team, the Black Panthers, was won by Arap Tomo.

These successes are indicative of what has been done for the last ten years, and it is interesting to know how far we have come.

Kenya's first national team to Africans in addition to the Gold Cup, was the 1963 Coronation Trophy, Mombasa Royal Regatta, which will long remember their exhibition match with the Kenyan team.

It is interesting to note that Olympia met a heroic end in the 500 metres. Is it risking too much to assume that?

It would be difficult to train the drivers and steering wheelmen to compete in such a race.

There is a tremendous potential in African sport, provided, as always, that there is a desire to succeed at all levels.

At school, in the townships and locations, Uniphilips, the local sports committee, and the Ministry of Education, where spectators are apt to behave in an excitable and狂妄的 manner, are to be congratulated for their efforts to keep competing temper in check.

In Rugby football, particularly at school, they are to be congratulated for the way they are seen in old boys' and other schools' teams. At cricket and hockey, however, there is no reason for them to be so competitive.

They should not make their marks, but if they do, let them have a happy change of heart.

Kenya's first national team to Africans, and in particular to the last, is the best barometer of progress.
















