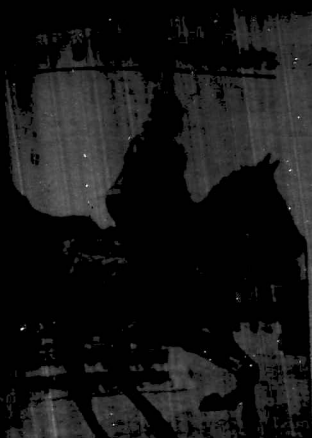

WOMEN LEARN A HOME ECONOMICS

IN a village formerly considered only by the sons of European writers, an educated young African woman has been teaching home economics to 14 African women who are to be African village leaders in turn, instruct thousands of women at Farmers' Training Centers throughout Kenya.

Mrs. Helen Williams, of Fort Hall, post-superintendent of the Kenya Extension Service, has been visiting at participants in Kenya's first home economics work held at Egerton College.

Working together they learned more efficient methods for all farm activities. From the method of sowing seeds to milking cows to milking calves, from cooking for the family to caring for baby for baby, they learned the best methods to be used in their own homes.

Why couldn't they have just as well used a doll? The answer of some of the other course participants "It would be so great, dolls don't require or cry and they don't have feelings that you must learn to be afraid of."

There was also classroom work, of course. Mrs. Margaret Coombs and Mrs. Abigail Inyang of Chiro, Coimbatore, and Mrs. Betty Inyang of Machakos College have instruction in farming, cooking, sewing, child health and sanitation.

Mrs. Alan George, District Agricultural Officer, Machakos, and Mrs. Betty Inyang, District Agricultural Officer, Chiro, were present. TWIN CAMELS ASSIST PASTURE RESEARCH

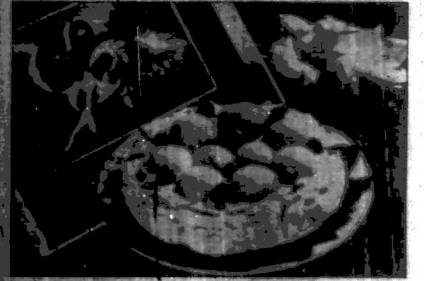

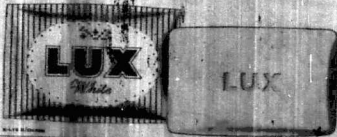

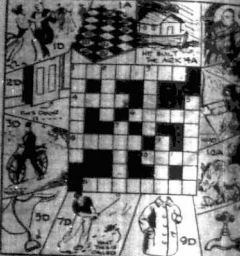

Be sealed sugar factory

The Kenya Government has co-operated in the further development programme and the new 2.5 million sugar factory which is being built by the Sugar Industries Ltd., Mombasa, in Nyandarua Region.

About 500 families are to be resettled in the leased area and each family will have about 2 acres of land. The chairman of the company, Mr. Maurice McLennan, said it was hoped later to allocate 2000 to 3000 plots in the undertaking.

It is in the company's strategic plan to have the Ministry of Lands and Settlement clear the land, though all decisions on land in this settlement are made by the company's board. It is expected that the activities would be completed by the end of the year.

CASH FROM PRIVATE SOURCES

The officials would then get from the company all the technical knowledge and guidance that might be necessary, Mr. McLennan said. The company would also manage and handle the transport of the cane to the factory when the crop was harvested. It would buy all the cane from the farmers.

Although the firm is collaborating with the Government in the settlement operation, the factory itself is financed mainly by private enterprise with no Government backing.

A Government spokesman said yesterday, however, that the factory would come under the Government's plan to zone the sugar-producing areas around Mombasa so that the growers would be guaranteed a supply of cane while the growers would be guaranteed a market. Private enterprise would be used in construction of the factory with the Government.

He said the company would be required to pay for the land over a period of years.

It was hoped that a co-operative society would be formed in the settlement area which would be able to purchase cane from the growers.

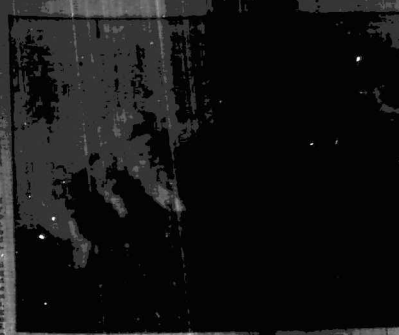

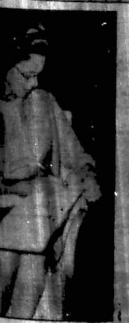

A MEETING OF senior British Ministers at No. 10 Downing Street, yesterday listened to proposals produced by the Colonial Secretary, Mr. Sandys, to wind up Kenya's constitutional conference.

The British Acting Premier, Mr. Butler, whose personal intervention had been sought in a cable from Kenya's Acting Premier, Mr. Mumburi, presided, with the Foreign Secretary, Lord Home, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. Maudling, the Leader of the Commons, Mr. Macleod, the War and Defence Ministers, Mr. Godber and Mr. Thornycroft, in attendance, together with the Chief of Defence Staff, Earl Mountbatten.

Such earlier Service representation was considered to be due to the conclusion of a defence agreement with Kenya rather than any immediate problem over Kani's "quit Kenya" resolution reflecting British troops in the event of an unfavorable declaration of Independence on Sunday.
