



FEW SURPRISES IN FRENCH ELECTIONS

INDECISIVE VOTING IN CONSTITUENCIES

HEAVY POLLING

BIG LEFT GAINS. COMMUNISTS MAY DOUBLE THEIR REPRESENTATION

The first ballot in the French elections has produced no sensational results, the chief features being the heavy polling and the abnormal number of constituencies in which the vote was indecisive owing to the plethora of candidates. Only ten per cent. of the electorate did not vote.

Latest figures indicate that the second ballot next Sunday will be necessary in 412 constituencies. Of the 179 candidates so far shown in the returns as definitely elected, the Right have 75, the Centre 42 and the Left 62.

Predictions have been realized in that there has been a marked swing-over to the Left. The Communists have secured the biggest gains and are expected to double their present representation in the Chamber. It is believed possible that the Socialists will replace the Radicals as the strongest party in the new Chamber.

ORDERLY POLLING

Paris, April 26. The elections opened very quietly and in the same atmosphere of calm as the first round. The whole electrological picture was very orderly.

The polling stations opened at 8 a.m. but it was almost not till before the first voters began to trickle in. M. Lohry, the President, was among the first to arrive. He walked to the polling station. The voting was broken by rain-factors arriving at the polls about half a minute. The Communist candidates of this round were not in the polling station.

The results will be announced from the Ministry by the Interior till the next hours of the morning; but the real test in the struggle between Left and Right will not be known till the second ballot has taken place.

First Surprise

The first surprise in the election was the failure of the Right, the Jacobin-Bourgeois leader, to secure an absolute majority in the first ballot at Lyons.

M. Flaudin, Minister of Foreign Affairs; M. Frossard, Minister of Labour; M. Heese, Minister of Education; and M. Duladier, the Premier, have been elected. M. Cahais, formerly Minister of Agriculture, M. Giscard d'Estaing, formerly Minister of Post and Telegraphs, and M. Fautoucci, formerly Minister of Education, are also elected.

Heavy Polling

Paris, April 27. Heavy polling with only 10 per cent. of the electorate voting, was a feature of yesterday's elections, together with an abnormal number of constituencies in which the voting was indecisive owing to the large number of candidates.

The state of the parties at 8.45 a.m. was as follows:

Right ... 60  
Centre ... 85  
Left ... 17

Of the 523 results so far known in the second ballot next Sunday, there have been no sensational defeats in any constituency. The Ministers have been re-elected with the exception of M. Giscard d'Estaing, Minister of Education, and M. Deat, Minister of Air, who, however, are not re-elected in their constituencies.

It is generally admitted that with the extreme Left gain in the second ballot classifies the situation, especially of the Radicals, as a critical moment. The Socialist and Communist parties, however, are not re-elected in their constituencies. The Communists, who have

KING FUAD DYING

Change for Worse Yesterday

'Sinking Fast'

ROY PRINCE HEIRO KEPT INFORMED

Riyadh, April 27. Although the Egyptian Legislature in London at this morning reported that during the night there had been no improvement in the condition of King Fuad, a message received yesterday from Cairo said it was a change for the worse.

ITALIAN THREATS TO ADDIS ABABA

POPULACE MUST SUBMIT OR WILL BE MASSACRED

Leaflets Dropped

RACE TO CAPITAL BETWEEN NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN ARMIES

Italian aeroplanes circling over Addis Ababa have dropped leaflets threatening the populace that unless they submit they will be massacred and their houses razed to the ground. The leaflets point out that if the Abyssinians submit they will benefit as the Italians will bring trade, property and civilization.

There has been fierce fighting on the southern front. It is felt that if the Italians are successful at Sannabash the way to Harar and the Djibouti railway will be open, and that there may therefore be a race between the northern and southern Italian armies to reach Addis Ababa first.

Fierce Fighting

It is officially confirmed that the Italian army captured Djibouti on the 24th. An Abyssinian counter-attack was repulsed.

In a counter-attack, British troops were fighting along the Djibouti railway line between Djibouti and Sannabash.

Race to Capital

It is believed that the Italian army is moving towards the capital of Addis Ababa, and that a race to the capital is being fought between the northern and southern Italian armies.



When six months ago the League declared Italy to be an aggressor it was the duty of the League, under Article 16 of the Covenant, to sever all diplomatic relations with Italy and to stop all communication between the nations of the League and Italy. Instead of this Italy is still a member of the League and her representative is given a place of honor at the League Powers Conference for sending a large number of soldiers into her territory.

Month after month the League has refused to apply any effective sanctions against Italy. Five months ago the League approved the application of all sanctions in principle. Ten weeks later the League appointed a committee of inquiry to study all sanctions. Nearly three months have now passed and the study of all sanctions is still going on. Meanwhile the League continues to supply Italy with oil and to provide her with facilities for the transport of war material. Nothing whatever is being done to help Abyssinia to resist the murderers.

Last December British public opinion made itself effective in opposing the decision of the British Cabinet to make a counter-subsidy to Mussolini. What is British public opinion going to do now? Is it going calmly to acquiesce in seeing the Abyssinians wiped out by every hellish device of murder? If any of the old spirit of liberty and sympathy with oppression still survives the voice of England will now speak so loudly that the Government will have to take immediate action, at least in principle, with respect that we are responsible for these atrocities and for consequences which have been given to Italy by the League of Nations.

**GOOD BAGS**

**Leopard and Elephant  
Adventures.**

An interesting safari has just been completed by two Swedish sportmen, Mr. Axel Johansson and Mr. K. Hultander, who are at present in Nairobi.

Arriving in Kenya from Stockholm, in January last, they made excursions in the Masai Reserve, the Tana River and Maukenia areas, Kericho and other places, and with the exception of a few days at the beginning of their safari, did not visit the services of a white hunter.

Mr. Johansson is the owner of large land estates, occupying some 40,000 acres of the finest forest land in the north of Sweden. Mr. Hultander, who has a brother in Nairobi, was a resident in the Colony from 1927 to 1932. His home is near Kisumu, on the Stuart River.

Arriving at Masai the party split up, and went their separate ways. Considerable trouble was experienced owing to heavy rain, and their safari was logged, time and again.

**Charged by Limpet**

Mr. Hultander's safari at night, as a rule had no white hunter, but he was accompanied by Mr. Hultander and some guides, and he was able to secure a number of skins, including a leopard, which was mounted.
