ALARMING STRIKE ALARMING IN FRANCE

IMPORTANT ARMAMENTS FACTORIES IDLE

250,000 People Involved

NEW GOVERNMENT'S WARNING OF DRASTIC ACTION

THE "stay-in" strike which started in several engineering works a few days ago and seemed likely to collapse has now flared up alarmingly.

The unions claim that over 200 factories in the Paris district have been immobilized including Peugeot, Hotchkiss, Thomson-Houston, several chemical and aeroplane factories, tens of thousands.

The strike epidemic has also spread to the provinces especially Lille and other Northern towns.

CONTINUING TO SPREAD

The strikes continue to spread as Leon Blum the first Socialist Premier takes over the Government.

To-day Mr. Salengro, the Minister for the Interior, issued a warning that the new Government would not tolerate illegal activities by the strikers and ordered that the occupied factories should be evacuated.

Meanwhile it is estimated that over a quarter of a million workers have struck so far.

TROUBLE EXTENDS

A letter message says the strike has spread to the employees of the Hachette Publishing Company, dislocating the newspaper delivery service.

The ice factory workers resumed work to-day, their demands having been granted, thus removing one of the major threats to the city's food supply.

The staffs of the big oil companies have now joined the general movement, threatening the distribution of public and private transport when the few day's supply of petrol is exhausted.

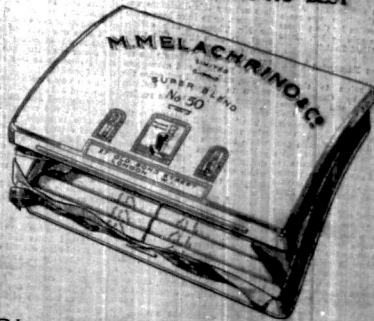
