

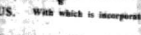

GERMAN PLAN TO CREATE A NEW CONTINENT

Europe Joined to Africa - Corn Lands in the Sahara

Plans to create a new continent, to be called "Atlantropa", by linking the level of the Mediterranean and thus joining Europe to Africa have been devised by a German architect and engineer, Herr Hermann Sörgel.

Herr Sörgel would like to build two gigantic dams, one at the Straits of Gibraltar and the other at the Bosphorus, to lower the level of water from the Atlantic and the Black Sea into the Mediterranean. These two dams would provide water-power of 20,000,000 horse power.

He admits that his plan would take at least 200 years to execute and that the political difficulties are almost insuperable in present-day Europe. But he thinks that the creation of the continent would "substitute the pleasure in the construction of the Bosphorus canals in constructive work for centuries to come."

AFRICA THE KEY

Herr Sörgel considers that the moment has come when the vast undeveloped spaces of Africa have become the necessary economic complement to a crowded Europe.

Before he set foot on Africa, Herr Sörgel says, the Mediterranean was mostly dry land. His proposal would raise sea-levels to the level of the straits for miles to be added to the 10 times more numerous valleys now scattered over the Sahara.

The Sahara would be irrigated by the waters of the Nile and the Congo Basins, which would be pumped to the desert with the water power from the two dams at Gibraltar and the Bosphorus.

If this gigantic scheme were carried out, Herr Sörgel declares, the population of the world would be solved for all time and people would gain vast new possibilities of development.

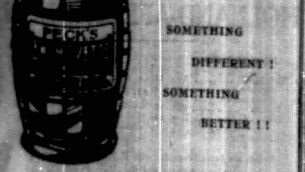

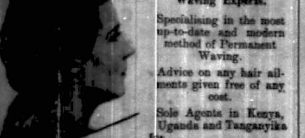

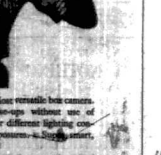

UNITED STATES KEEPS THE AMERICA'S CUP.

CHALLENGER BEATEN BY HALF MILE IN CLOSE RACE.

Mr. Sopwith May Not Try Again.

RANGER'S HULL DESIGN OPENS NEW ERA IN YACHTING. United States retain the America's Cup. On Thursday Mr. Harold Vanderbilt, defender, defeated Mr. T. O. M. Sopwith, challenger, Endeavour II in the fourth race of the series.

The final race proved to be the closest, Ranger only winning by just over half a mile. The wind probably favoured Endeavour II but when she crossed the starting line too quickly her chance faded away.

Ranger's time for the thirty miles triangular course was a record, beating that of Endeavour I made in 1924.

A £2,000,000 Quest.

Mr. Vanderbilt's craft retained her commanding lead on the homeward stretch. Ranger's time was a record for the triangular course—3 hours 7 minutes 48 seconds.

As the United States retain the America's Cup, Mr. Sopwith's efforts have been made in vain. The time was approximately 3:10. In the second of his quest it is estimated that it has cost them £2,000,000, and the same for Endeavour II.

A New Era in Yachting. At the conclusion of the race Mr. Sopwith warmly congratulated Mr. Vanderbilt, who has received checks of telegrams.

Asked if he would challenge again, Mr. Sopwith said he had no idea whether he would come back or not. Mr. Vanderbilt said he had not thought of defending should there be another challenge.

Mr. Sopwith attributed Ranger's victory to the shape of her hull which he believed had secured a new era in yacht construction. All the newspapers are full in their praise of the sporting spirit in which the races have been sailed.

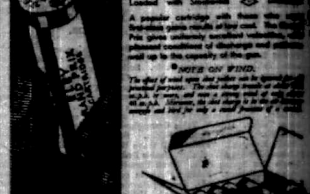

Legislative Council on Monday approved a motion submitted by the Acting Director of Agriculture for the... of an exclusive trading licence for the purchase of native grown tobacco in the Sagana and Kitui districts.

The mover said that for some years the Department had desired to develop Native tobacco industries but had been unable to find the necessary capital. Main objects for the acquisition of these were to provide the local market with cigarettes and to give the Natives a really high priced crop.

Most Members were in agreement with the motion, but Major Grogan asked whether the ultimate objective was an export trade or the elimination of the import of tobacco. If the former were intended, it would be a pity to foster a particular produce for export which would compete seriously with other places in British Africa.

The Acting Director said that since 1933 some three or four proposals had been put to Government but the latter had decided that they did not come within the conditions laid down in the Ordinance. ELECTED MEMBERS SUPPORT GIVING DISCRETION TO GOVERNMENT

The report of the Select Committee appointed to consider and report upon the provisions of the Trade Unions Bill was adopted in Legislative Council on Tuesday after a somewhat lengthy debate.

There was also a minority report by Mr. A. M. Maini, also adopted, but which was not approved. One of the main points was that there should be a right of appeal to a Court in preference to the Governor-in-Council, and this principle was supported by other members.

Major the Hon. F. W. Cavendish-Bentinck (Nairobi North) while in sympathy with Mr. Maini's view felt that the Bill should go through as it stood with the Committee's amendments, and if necessary it could always be reviewed at a later stage in the light of experience.

Review After Experience

The Acting Attorney General moved that the Select Committee's report with the exception of the Minority report, be adopted by the Council.

The Select Committee, added the speaker, recommended five amendments to the Bill, but some were of great consequence. In the absence of the power of the Legislature representing additional information from a body applying for registration it had been made quite clear that unless the required information was given, then that Trade Union would not be registered.

The Committee had also been of the opinion that in the event of the non-compliance of the registration of any Trade Union, the two months' notice of cancellation should be allowed to run its course. The Minister in reply to the Minister stated that while in agreement with the majority of the proposals of the other members of the Select Committee, he was strongly opposed to one particular matter. He paid tribute to his colleagues on the Committee for their great patience in listening to the points on which he differed.

The Appeal

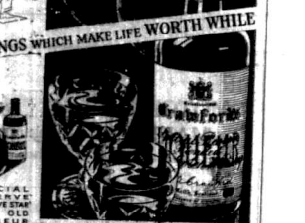
