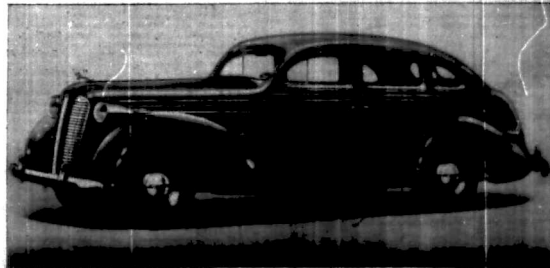

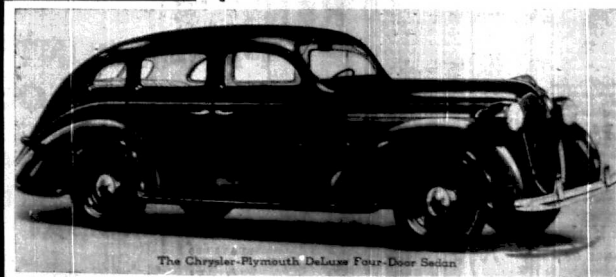



Weather will be mainly fair generally but there is a chance of local afternoon or evening showers in most districts.



Shipbuilding 350 Miles From Sea

LOCAL FIRM'S PRODUCT

70 Tons Cargo Boat for Lake Tanganyika

To design and build in its entirety a 70-ton, 40-hp. motor cargo boat is no small task for an engineering shop that is 350 miles from the sea. This has recently been accomplished in the Nairobi workshops of Messrs. Haack and Bell Ltd., and the undertaking is being completed in the same class of work done in the Railway shops, the largest industrial piece of engineering to be completed in the Kenya capital. It is certainly the most substantial piece of engineering so far carried out by a local concern.

Designed by the firm's engineering staff, the vessel is named "the Bata" and is 44 feet in length, 10 feet 6 inches in beam, has a draught of 4 feet, and moulded depth of 6 feet.

DO POROPIRONS SHOOT THEIR QUILLS?

To the Editor, "E. A. Standard." Sir—I do not understand why you should give the insignificant prospecting so much publicity and prominence in your paper and actually go so far as inviting public expression on the question of poropirons and their ability to pierce or shoot dead-fishing quills. Men who have lived in Africa for a considerable time know full well that it is just as easy for poropirons to pierce the quills of a fish as it is for the fish to pierce the quills of a poropiron to shoot their quills and warship their prey.

It is a fact that a kind of Manu active raised a Wapole-Village near Dodoma and captured a large number of poropirons and Wapole. The following day the Wapole received their money and enlisted a large number of poropirons and a light company of the Manu regiment and they are now in hot normal to try and recapture their quills, preferably and their women. The Wapole was established contact with the Manu regiment and a heated and bloody conflict ensued. Without doubt the Manu were victorious and so state in short that the Wapole had from the very commencement of the action and were it not for a unguiltless Bank, the movement by a light battalion of dismounted poropirons, supported by a company of light-artillery poropirons and a dismounted company of stinks who were commanded on the left and who at the eleventh hour delivered a brilliant rear-guard action by way of a gallop, the Manu were victorious.

The Manu Government has greatly praised the poropirons for the accurate long range shooting of their quills—especially the poropirons. By way of all information on this all important question of the poropirons, I would like to allow me space to state that poropirons often damage their quills in the low level areas where they are more plentiful than in the higher altitudes. I have happened by had occasion to drive them out of their lands by putting the dogs after them. A trained and experienced dog will always make the Manu retreat over a poropiron in order to avoid its protruding quills, and it is at the back of the head and with a sharp snout and jerk over its head. Many intruders do not have a close approach on account of the poropiron's bristling and threatening quills. I have seen more than one occasion when untrained dogs have cornered a poropiron in a bush and knocked its head in with a stone which is in the bush.

I emphatically state that it is just as easy for poropirons to shoot their quills as it is for a poropiron to pierce the quills of a fish and send air by their first terminal cut.

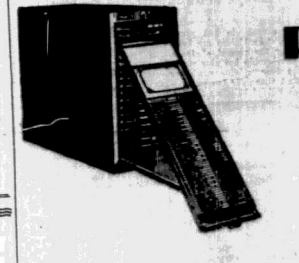

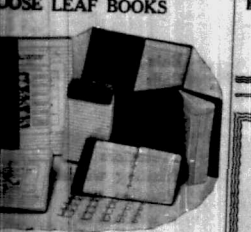

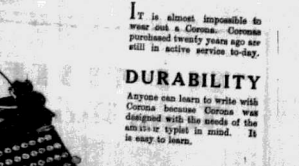

EVE-OF-CONFERENCE SENSATION

RUSSIA DIRECTLY ACCUSES ITALY

"Indubitable Proofs"

FULL COMPENSATION AND EXEMPLARY PUNISHMENT DEMANDED

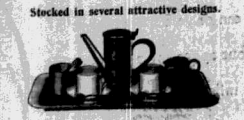
