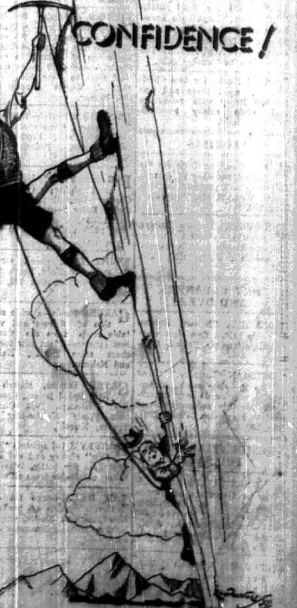

FILTER BRITAIN CAMPAIGN

Prime Minister to Broadcast Appeal

[“STANDARD” CORRESPONDENT.] London, By Air. The British Prime Minister, Mr. Neville Chamberlain, is to broadcast an Empire Appeal on September 10 to urge people to become voluntary filterers.

October will be devoted to a general broadcast, urging the Government—through a Filter Bill Team, The King Health Services, November and December will be devoted to national and child welfare saving January to school and dental services, February to tuberculosis, breast cancer and other services for adolescents and adults.

In March there will be a link-up with the National Fitness Council, which will direct attention to his facilities for physical training and recreation.

Millions of leaflets will be distributed which will be displayed by local authorities, meetings will be addressed by members of the Government, and films of health leaflets will be distributed.

Mr. Chamberlain's speech will be made at a reception at the League of Nations and Empire Exhibition, in co-operation with the Central Council for Health Education.

Kilimanjaro Rioting Extends

POLICE REINFORCEMENTS BROUGHT IN

The rioting among the Wachagga has been continuing and extended.

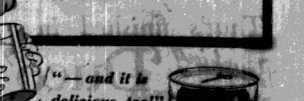

to have it and I don't think anything we say will stop it," he concluded.

Mr. W. T. Shapley stated that the provision for the income tax was introduced as a direct negative of the substantive motion. The amendment was welcomed by Mr. Lewis.

Not Equitable

Mr. Shapley dealt with various points raised by Major Brown. The first point was the statement that the tax was equitable. Mr. Shapley stated that several of the United Nations party to what had been "disagreed among other things as a compromise" had agreed that income tax was not equitable and was never capable of equitable adjustment. With one goal to contain the speaker submitted that it was the experience of the constitutionalists that given an increase in local production if there was going to be properly levied the Customs revenue would go up and not down.

Major Brown had suggested they should give a charter and that this legislation would come so weight with Government. With regard to that Mr. Shapley stated that had not been in the country. America's Protest

TRADE INTERESTS ON COFFEE BOARD

New Arrangement Set Out in Bill

A Bill to amend the Coffee Industry Ordinance, 1924, is published in the current issue of the Official Gazette. It is stated that His Excellency the Governor has approved of the introduction into Legislative Council.

The object and reason state that as the control of the production and trading interests, represented on the Coffee Board and on the other hand jointly by the Coffee Traders' Association of Kenya and the Coffee Section of the Members' Chamber of Commerce and Agriculture, trade representation on the Coffee Board was withdrawn from the Board with effect from July 1.

Changes of the Bill are designed to give legislative effect to the arrangements for granting for an increase of coffee plantations on the Board from six to eight; and to provide for the transfer of a plantation license when the possession of the plantation is transferred during the validity of a license.
