VISITORS TO WAR MUSEUM

Big Increase This Year

["STANDARD" correspondence] London, September 10.—Although it is 20 years since the War, visitors are still flocking to the Imperial War Museum in large numbers. During the first 12 months in the new building, which opened on July 6, 1935, the total was 568,223. This had increased by March, 1936, to 674,219, and for the portion of the year covered by the monthly annual report, issued yesterday (Monday) Oct. 1, rose to 645,000. The figure was 38,827.

AFRICAN TOURIST CONGRESS IN OCTOBER

Proposal For Cape To Cairo Dorsal Route

Delegates from the Automobile Association of Great Britain and British Tourist Clubs, from European countries with territorial interests in Africa and from all African territories interested in tourist traffic will attend the "African Tourist Congress" to be held at Costermansville from October 6 to October 11.

One question of particular importance to East African territories is the proposal—expected to receive strong support from many delegates—for a dorsal route from the Cape to Cairo through the Congo and north through French territory.

The "African Tourist Congress" is a conference of delegates from all East African territories in a new and final stage of progress towards the realization of the Cape to Cairo Road. The Congress, under the auspices of the Belgian Congo Government, will be held at Costermansville, Belgian Congo from October 6 to October 11. It has been promoted by the Belgian Touring Club, which has organized over 1,500 organizations with a combined membership of over 100,000.

Purpose of Congress. The purpose of the Congress is to coordinate, facilitate, and develop the road network throughout Africa by rail, air, and water.

Delegates will attend from the following countries: Belgium, Congo, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom. The British Tourist Clubs, from all African territories in Africa, and from all African territories in Africa, and from all African territories in Africa.
