'AUDACITY' WILL TO PEACE

MR. NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN, THE BRITISH PRIME MINISTER, MET THE GERMAN CHANCELLOR YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AT BERCHTESGADEN TO DISCUSS PEACEFUL MEANS OF SETTLING THE CZECHOSLOVAKIAN PROBLEM. MR. CHAMBERLAIN MADE A DRAMATIC ANNOUNCEMENT OF HIS VISIT LATE ON WEDNESDAY NIGHT, AND HIS ACTION IS HALLED THROUGHOUT THE WORLD AS A MOMENTOUS GESTURE FOR PEACE. 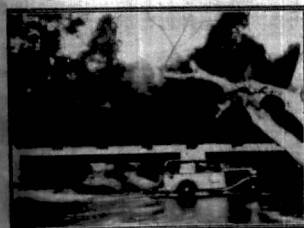

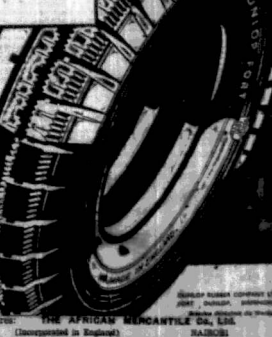

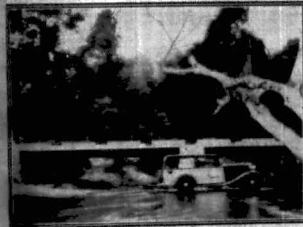

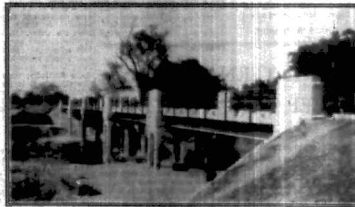

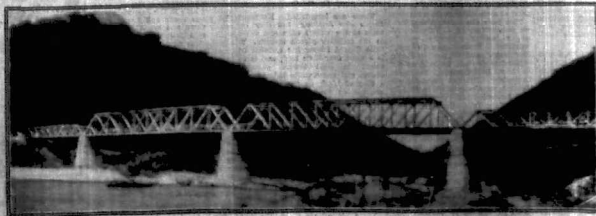

THE STATEMENT POINTS OUT THAT BRITAIN HAS KEPT IN CLOSE TOUCH WITH THE DOMINIONS, WITH FRANCE, AND WITH THE UNITED STATES, "WHOSE SYMPATHY IS PRECIOUS TO BRITAIN AT ALL TIMES, AND PARTICULARLY AT TIMES LIKE THIS."

London, September 15.—An important statement of the British policy was made on Sunday night last night. The statement declared that the British government has kept in close touch with the Dominions, with France, and with the United States, "whose sympathy is precious to Britain at all times, and particularly at times like this."

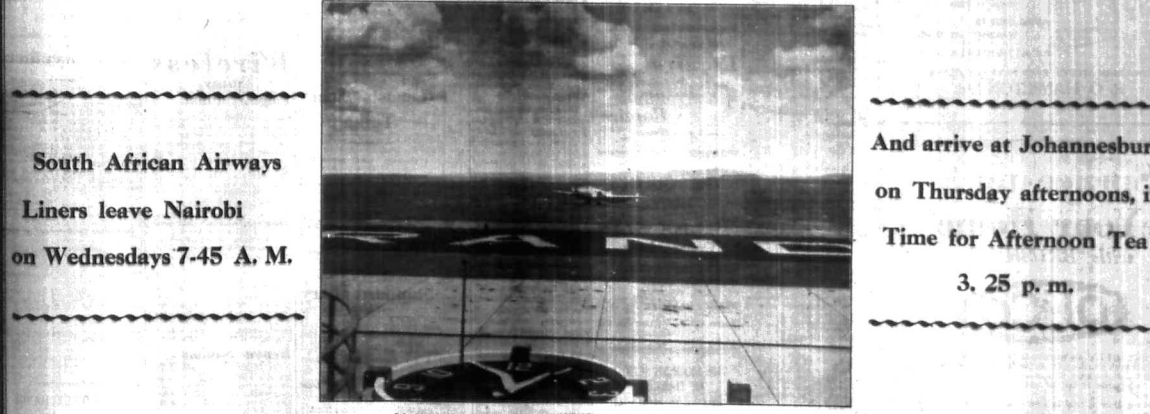

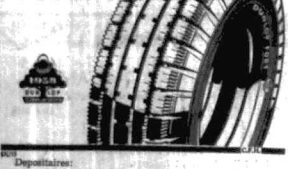
