NEW CZECH MILITARY GOVERNMENT STRENGTHENS GARRISONS ON SUDETEN BORDER

Clashes With Herr Henlein's "Free Corps"

RUSSIA WARNS POLAND

THE CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN HERR HITLER AND MR. CHAMBERLAIN AT DOBERBERG—ABOUT WHICH THERE ARE MANY RUMOURS BUT NOT OFFICIALLY IS KNOWN—DID NOT RESUME YESTERDAY MORNING AS EXPECTED. MR. CHAMBERLAIN SENT A LETTER TO WHICH IT IS BELIEVED THAT HERR HITLER REPLIED LATER IN THE DAY. AT LEAST ONE MORE MEETING IS EXPECTED TO TAKE PLACE, HOWEVER.

A number of serious clashes are reported from Sudeten areas where the Czech frontier garrisons are being strengthened by the new Czech Government, which has a Military Premier. The incoming Czech troops are being raised by Herr Henlein's "Free Corps" many of whom, according to reports from the border, have given the people to understand that the German army was following them.

The agitation in Poland and Hungary for the return of the territories which were lost in 1918, continues to be most violent, but Russia has warned Poland—where there have been demonstrations shouting "March on Czecho-Slovakia"—that it will abrogate her Treaty of Non-Aggression with Poland if Poland violates Czech territory.

On September 23, Mr. Chamberlain and Herr Hitler were also interviewed. After the meeting the British leader issued a statement supporting the case for and order in Czecho-Slovakia.

After saying that the conversation would be published in a statement sent on to say that of the meeting the first impression of the opinion of the Prime Minister was that there should be a determination on the part of all parties concerned to secure that the local conditions in Czecho-Slovakia were such as to do no injury to the peace and good conversation.

Diplomats Busy In London

London, September 23. Mr. Chamberlain's visit to the Air Minister, Sir Kingsley Wood, and the Foreign Secretary, Mr. Simon D'Arcy, was the subject of a dispatch in the Evening Standard.

At Copenhagen, he appealed to the necessity to everyone to assist in maintaining a firm action of any kind likely to lead to incidents.

Although nothing is known of the nature of the discussion which took place, the Evening Standard understands to date that only the Sudeten German people, but also the possibility of an settlement were discussed.

The Czech forces were disbanded by Sudeten authorities. The Czechs have been one of the first matters mentioned. They followed the disbanding of the Czechs, the establishment of the new frontiers of the Czechs, and the question of Hungary.

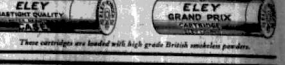
