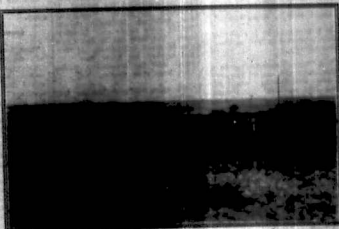

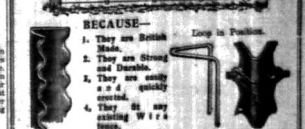

AMAZING TRIBUTES TO MR. CHAMBERLAIN

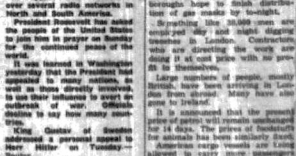

Something of real value for the future wellbeing of humanity will be gained if people who are mentally fit like Hitler have been convinced, however unwillingly, that they cannot continue to break international law without a determined effort being made to stop them.

There will be no war. That is the first essential fact of the Munich Conference. After all the complications and at the eleventh hour reason has triumphed over the madness which brought the world to the very brink of war.

There can be little doubt that the main lines of the settlement will be accepted by all concerned and that the outside world and that war will break out in the immediate future, but for peace a long time to come.

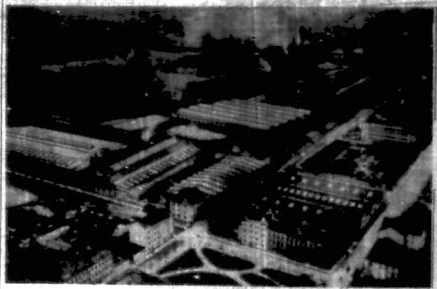

INSURANCE AGAINST FAILURE AT EXAMS.

Co-operative Insurance against failure of examinations with "Red Line" for policy holders, may now be had by the University students.
