DEADLOCK IN SLOVAK-HUNGARY DISCUSSIONS

Ukrainians Riot In Poland

Road and Weather Report

Thunderstorms have been general this week in the Taitavyi Territory, Sanghar Valley, in the Kericho district and in the Rift Valley. Heavy rains are expected later, when the Western Province of Uganda and in the Lake area in Tanganyika.

In Kericho the wettest places this week were Nairobi and Kericho with 22 inches of rain, followed by Kisumu with 21 inches, Sanghar with 21 inches, Fort Yermak with 21 inches, and Kapchori, Malindi, Mtwara, Mera and Soko with 21 inches.

Roads on the whole are in fair condition.

In Uganda, 8 inches of rain are recorded at Mukono, 3 inches at Masindi and Kumi, 2 1/2 inches at Mbarazi and 2 inches at Kabali. All roads are in good condition. In Tanganyika, the wettest places this week was Busoga with 21 inches, followed by Muevu with 1 inch and Mpora with three quarters of an inch.

Roads are dry but rough in many places.

K. F. A. Market Report

The Kenya Farmers' Association
(Co-operative Ltd., Nairobi, has
submitted the following market re-
port for the week ending October
12:

Wheat The grain market is undergoing
a set-to to settle down to normal
conditions after the political upsets
which have recently occurred. It is
to be realized that immediately the
policy of the Government in regard
to the maize price advanced rapidly,
and sales of maize on the water
were made at figures 4/7 to 4/8
above the previous ruling price. A
great deal of this maize remains
in the hands of the purchasers,
and their necessity are anxious to
get out with as small a loss as
possible with the result that they
are selling making a high price
concurrent with what purchasers
are willing to give.

The general maize position is
that both the United States and
the Argentine have exported up to
twenty-four million bushels in the
past year, slightly over 50 per cent, of
their total exportable surplus. This
means that there is little likelihood
of any improvement in the price.
A further factor is that the war
has had an immediate effect on the
supply situation, 683 quarters being
short shipped to Europe during
the past week compared with 225
quarters the previous week, and
1,025,000 quarters for the corre-
sponding week a year ago. This
reduces the monthly surplus and
if it continues, will mean that
there will be a dearth of maize
resulting in further price reduc-

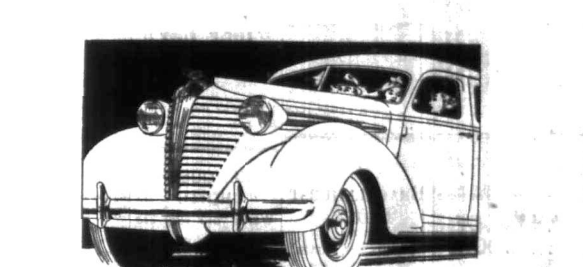

Your child's Hands

Marianne Raynor

HAVE you ever noticed the shape of your child's hands? Although you may or may not believe in palmistry, you will probably agree that it is only reasonable to expect that the shape of the hand should have some bearing upon the owner of it. Your child's hands, chubby and undeveloped though they may be in early life, often give valuable indications of the kind of person he or she will grow into later on.

The study of a child's hand will frequently furnish the kind of mind he possesses, or show some natural leaning in a particular direction. This knowledge, which before comes from the hand, may be obtained from the hand long before the child is old enough to tell you what he can make of his own hand when they grow up.

The diagrams given here are the squares drawn from the hands of six children of various ages and circumstances. Though some should be taken as a perfect type—yet every hand is individually different—each of the six falls roughly into a separate class, and indicates certain tendencies.

In Fig. 2 we see the square hand, thin and narrow, with moderate fingers. It is a strange thing, but recent comparisons show that many great artists, musicians, and writers do possess the square hand. To get the square hand, as shown in Fig. 1, the explanation is simple. 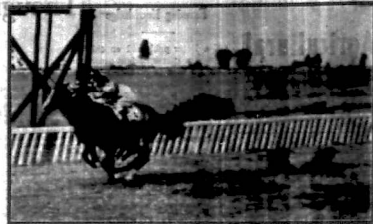

REFUGEES PROBLEM

The £10,000,000 advance which the Government is asking the Bank of England to make to Czechoslovakia immediately will, it is understood, be used to help the refugees and the Government is considering the possibility of overseas settlement for them.

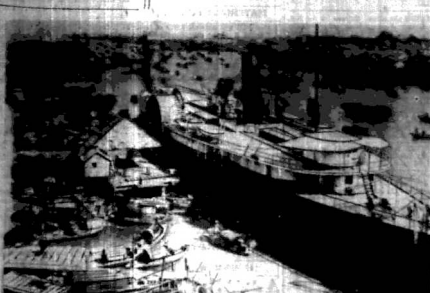
