ONE THOUSAND MILES TO BROADCAST

Africans Speak To Madagascar

[From a correspondent]
African civilians from all parts of East Africa, Tanganyika, Kenya and Uganda, arrived recently at the invitation of the Army to broadcast in Madagascar.

Their flight came from such distant places as Arusha, Gothic, Kilimanjaro, Mbeya, Dar es Salaam, Mombasa, and even from Tukuyu in Tanganyika. The last involved a long journey across the Great Lakes, and the aircraft had to land at Lake Victoria, and at the port of Kisumu, before reaching the coast. They arrived by road, rail, and sea, and came by sea, and the Army transported them across the Indian Ocean and across, although the distance he had to fly was not quite so great.

All together 44 African citizens came to Madagascar, and the president of the Kenyan Association of Teachers and the students in the afternoon and one from the Tanganyikan Association and one friend of the Kenyan Police who took part in the programme.

Not "Bintey"
Officers who arranged the broadcast explained the lack of "white-teachers" on the part of the African teachers, and the fact that there was a microphone before them. The reason was that it was difficult due to the language problem to distinguish between the two, and the fact that many could not or did not understand English when it was enunciated and placed near their microphones. Each teacher had to make a complete recitation of the stand on which he was going to speak on behalf of his race.

They obviously ensured that they spoke especially natives and many of them seemed to have planned what they were going to say in their half-minute.

In the actual broadcast behind the scenes was difficult, arranging the Africans, hearing them, and getting them to speak. It had not been possible without the support and encouragement of the Army. Commanders, who spared no effort to help the Africans, who wanted for the broadcast, many of whom had never been on a ship before the Beans. Having found them they made arrangements for them to speak, and they were properly provided for on board.

Firing the Gun
The story of the main speaker, Captain J. G. H. Parker, arrived with only the clothes in which he left home, and the few personal items and the majority, the personal belongings of the members of the Reserves. On arrival in Madagascar they were given full protection, and食事 was provided.

There in Nairobi there were several aeroplanes and heavy AAA anti-aircraft guns and anti-tank weapons. Some of them almost overlapped to find the gun. An old Maquisant who had been in the gun, said that he had to do that and was heard to remark: "Let me get off this gun, I am not fit to be a gunner."

It is certain that these Africans will be welcomed back to Nairobi and the thrill of being able to speak again to their friends and relatives as far away in Madagascar.
