M. VAN ZEELAND'S PLAN FOR WORLD RECOVERY

Asks Great Powers to Come Together

THE EX-BELGIAN PRIME MINISTER, M. VAN ZEELAND, IN HIS REPORT WHICH HAS BEEN ISSUED IN LONDON AND PARIS, SUGGESTS THAT MEETINGS SHOULD BE CONVENED BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEADING ECONOMIC POWERS TO CONSIDER WHETHER AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED ON THE GENERAL PRINCIPLES WHICH MAY BE EMBODIED IN A PACT OF ECONOMIC COLLABORATION.

The report is the outcome of a world survey of economic conditions carried out by M. Van Zeeland at the request of the British and French Governments.

M. Van Zeeland says the economic Powers should first consider whether they will agree to take part in an attempt to bring about closer economic collaboration and, if so, state their attitude to the various recommendations in his report.

London, January 28.—M. Van Zeeland has presented his report on the economic situation of Britain and France on the investigation that he made into the possibility of obtaining a general reduction of the obstacles to international trade.

Mr. Eden Invites Co-operation From Non-Members

MR. According to a report received from Berlin, Germany has re-organized, enlarged, and modernized the old Colonial School at Wittenhausen, which was established by Professor Ernst Albert Fabianus in 1886.

Its purpose is to give many of Germany's young men a thorough training for life overseas, particularly in tropical countries. The school course lasts for three years, one year being devoted entirely to practical work.

In the three-year period the students learn to apply themselves to everything that is essential to their future career. They have courses in all branches of farming and tropical agriculture, in the study of tropical soils, in how to handle various horses, cows, pigs, and sheep.

They are also taught how to erect stables and barns, how to grow trees, forests, and other commercial crops, and how to use machinery and tools.

They are given training in the history, geography, and modern conditions of the tropical countries, and in the use of the typewriter, the gramophone, and the radio.

INCOME TAX

More Critics of the Measure
To the Editor, "E. A. Standard," Sir—Having recently come back from Kenya...

I should like to make one or two observations in regard to this Tax which is considered to be a great handicap to a poor and struggling country.

A loan was floated in Kenya a short time before the Income Tax Act was brought in, giving interest at 10 per cent...

I am therefore already a lower to capital value of at least 5 per cent and in addition I have to pay the tax on the income.

I may say that if this sort of development is the Government's idea of "compensation" it leaves a very bad impression on me.

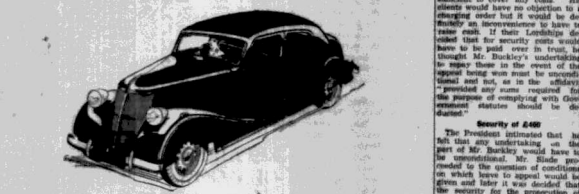

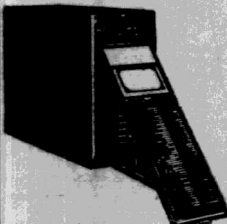

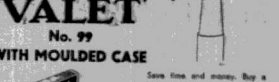
