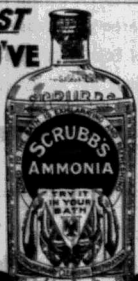

## Mr. Eden's hopes of New World Agreement

The fact that the British Government has, for some months, been investigating problems of air warfare, preparatory to proposals for an international agreement to control the bombardment of cities, is a fact which is well known to the public. It is, however, not generally known that the British Government has also been investigating the possibility of a new world agreement, which would be a step towards the prevention of air bombing.

It was also stated in a letter debate that the British Government had offered to both sides in Spain that their good offices in trying to reach an agreement to stop the dangers to civilians from indiscriminate bombing.

London, February 3.—The House of Commons has tonight passed a resolution, proposed by Mr. James (Labour) Secretary, Mr. Anthony Eden, regarding the possibility of a new world agreement, which would be a step towards the prevention of air bombing.

The spokesman for the Government in the debate on the motion was the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, Mr. Anthony Eden, who said that the British Government had offered to both sides in Spain that their good offices in trying to reach an agreement to stop the dangers to civilians from indiscriminate bombing.

## League's Action "Inadequate"

### Arctic Scientists In Peril

### CAMP ICE FLOE CRACKING UP

Moscow, February 2.—A report reaching Moscow from the Russian scientific expedition to the Arctic says that as a result of six days' heavy storms the ice floe on which the party of scientists are floating south has cracked and the expedition is cut off from two of its food bases and stores.

## East Africa Gold Mining

### TANGANYIKA'S RECORD GOLD EXPORT

#### £526,277 Left Territory Last Year

All previous records have been eclipsed by the mineral export figures for 1931, the estimated total value being £526,277, of which gold exports amounted for £375,777.

These figures are well in excess of those for 1930, which amounted to £394,125, of which gold accounted for £260,490. It is thus the first occasion in the Territory's history when its gold exports in any one year have exceeded half a million sterling in value.

The total value of last year's gold exports was almost equal to that of that for the entire decade preceding it. The period (1920-1931) accounting for gold to the value of £1,710,000.

The net exports (increased in value this year) in 1931 were £526,277, less than for 1930, but due to the decrease in gold and diamonds, but diamonds increased from £82,971 to £97,711.

For the month of December, 1931, gold exports were slightly less than the comparative months of 1930, the value of £47,233, compared with £47,267, but this total was greater than that for November 1931, which totalled £38,276.

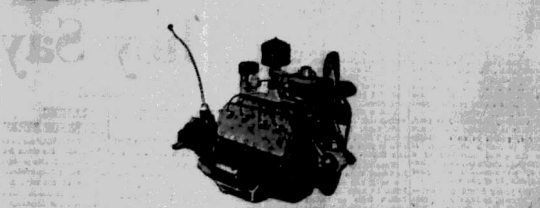

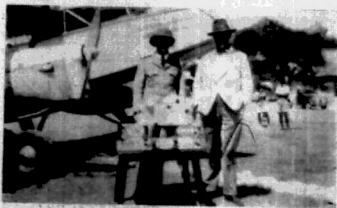

# M. VAN ZEELAND'S PLAN FOR WORLD RECOVERY

### THE EX-BELGIAN PRIME MINISTER, M. VAN ZEELAND, IN HIS REPORT WHICH HAS BEEN ISSUED IN LONDON AND PARIS, SUGGESTS THAT MEETINGS SHOULD BE CONVENED BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEADING ECONOMIC POWERS TO CONSIDER WHETHER AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED ON THE GENERAL PRINCIPLES WHICH MAY BE EMBODIED IN A PACT OF ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION.

This report is the outcome of a world survey of economic conditions carried out by M. Van Zeeland at the request of the British and French Governments.

M. Van Zeeland says the economic Powers should first consider whether they will agree to take part in an attempt to bring about closer economic co-operation, and then to consider their attitude to the various recommendations in his report.

London, January 28. M. Van Zeeland has presented his report to the Governments of Britain and France on the investigation that he made into the possibility of obtaining a general reduction of the obstacles to international trade.

M. Van Zeeland says he found great agreement everywhere but much reserve as regards the carrying out of the plan.

As an outlet, M. Van Zeeland outlines the preliminary questions of whether international co-operation is to be based on a pact of economic co-operation or on a pact of economic co-operation and disarmament.

He says that what actually came about, however desirable, is only a partial realization of the plan.

# CHANGES COMING TO EAST AFRICAN STRUGGLE?

## Rumours of Either "Big Push" or Armistice

### ANGLO-JAP. RELATIONS

The proclaiming of martial law in Canton has given rise to the report—also received from Shanghai—that there had been an attempted coup d'etat by a former rebel against the Chiang Kai-shek government. This is the view of the Government of the Province, who says the reason for martial law is the expected heavy Japanese bombing.

In the Japanese Diet a question was asked in which it was suggested that Britain was Japan's principal enemy. The Foreign Minister said "I cannot see a single case in which Britain has acted offensively against Japan."

The Japanese army is believed to be planning the early creation of a new Chinese puppet government, with headquarters at Nanking, which is intended to replace the present provisional government of China.

It is believed from a neutral source that the Japanese are planning to occupy the North China coast, and to establish a puppet government there.

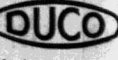
