## HITLER ASSUMES SUPREME ARMY COMMAND

## Sweeping changes favour Nazi Control

**INSTANTANEOUS AND SWEEPING CHANGES IN THE GERMAN HIGH COMMAND, HEINRICH HITLER HAS TAKEN DIRECT MILITARY CONTROL INTO HIS OWN HANDS AND SUPERSEDED THE FORMER LEADERSHIP OF THE ARMY.**

A new council—a cabinet within a cabinet—will advise the Fuehrer on foreign, as well as military affairs.

Van Ribbentrop is recalled from his ambassadorship to become the new German Foreign Minister.

Never before has such a powerful body as the new Cabinet Council, created in Germany, and never a head of the Reich held such direct control over the armed forces.

## ON TREATY LIMITS

## Britain, France and America Request Information

**STERNLY-WORDED NOTES ARE BEING SENT TO JAPAN BY THE GOVERNMENTS OF BRITAIN, FRANCE AND THE UNITED STATES, REQUESTING ASSURANCES THAT JAPAN IS NOT BUILDING WARSHIPS BEYOND TREATY LIMITS.**

In the absence of assurance, the three Powers must assume that reports that Japan is exceeding Treaty limits are correct.

Combined action follows upon exchanges of information between Britain, the United States and France, and is calculated to afford Japan a last chance to keep the size of her ships and guns in conformity with those of the other Powers—or else to assume the responsibility for unrestricted building in the two major categories of naval power.

London, February 5. Great Britain and the United States have asked Japan to send them an assurance that she is not building warships which do not conform to the provisions of the 1930 London Naval Treaty.

If Japan does not give this assurance, the three Powers intend to take steps to restrict her armaments.

**RINDERPEST**

A Conference in Nairobi

Experts in Veterinary Science from nearly all the Territories in Africa south of the Equator are meeting in Nairobi, this week to discuss the problem of Rinderpest. Elimination is immensely difficult in the whole of the Continent and even adequate control is costly. It is the great handicap to the full development of the beef export industry. Kenya has already tried to obtain the control of this pest. Government to the development of an export trade in chilled and frozen beef has been tried with the same answer. The British Government will not

agree to run the risk of importing Rinderpest. The disease is one of the great economic problems of the East African Territories. While it exists, full and balanced development of the stock-raising potentialities of the Territories cannot take place and these countries are left to languish on the uneconomic alternative of trying to run dairy farming on ranching land.

Rinderpest is marching south and southern are alarmed. That is why they are in Nairobi today. Their great livestock and beef export industries will be threatened unless something is done. In April last year, a member of the Tanganyika Legislative Council maintained that the Government of the Mandated Territory was fighting a lone battle, unaided by the people in the South for whose protection the law was trying its best to carry out an expensive control policy. At that date, he said, Rinderpest had crossed the Central Railway of Tanganyika and the shorter line from Lake Tanganyika to the coast. The whole energies of the Veterinary Department were concentrated on trying to prevent the march of the disease and other requirements and considerations of stock policy and of stock-owners were sufficient to consume them. He offered two alternatives: (1) concentration on an attempt to push back the disease, and establishing a line of defence along the Kenya-Tanganyika border; (2) the deliberate spread of Rinderpest throughout the whole of Tanganyika by double-inoculation, giving local protection at a reasonable cost and transferring the whole burden of defence to the Rhodesia-Nyasaland Portuguese East Africa and the Union.

The complaint in Tanganyika is that the Territory is being asked to carry out a policy laid down for it by the Secretary of State for the Colonies based on the interests of the southern Territories and only made possible at the expense and to the detriment of Tanganyika. It is maintained that the South should be helping both with men and money, and that is one of the aspects of the problem which the present Conference will have to consider. These young Territories, short both of men and money, cannot be expected to carry the burden unaided, nor can they be expected to rest permanently content with an unbalanced livestock development policy. On at least one occasion Rinderpest was almost stamped out in Tanganyika but it flared up again in adjacent areas, and as Tanganyika sees the position today no steps can be taken to prevent its return alone warrant the belief that the disease can be controlled.

The countries to the South are unlikely to agree to a policy of despair. Though it might well be easier for East Africa to allow the spread of Rinderpest and depend on double-inoculation to give measure of immunity to the stock which would not be a net, that is not a policy which in the long run can be other than disastrous for Africa and detrimental to the whole of the stock industry of the Continent. Partial control on the present scale is too expensive and uncertain. There remains extermination but no campaign can be carried out with any hope of success unless the whole available forces and resources of the continent, including the Equator, are combined for the attack. And there is no certainty of success. Once Rinderpest is exterminated would involve the complete disappearance of game. A policy of complete eradication would involve enormous cost and a long-range policy which might well cause Legislatures in the young countries to pause and consider when no guarantee of success is possible.

In Kenya control is based on a policy aimed at the "hot" areas which are in the "dry" areas where outbreaks are suppressed in accordance with the general trend of the accessibility of the district: south of that into Tanganyika, the "hot" areas where suppression is not possible, and again, below the Central Railway of Tanganyika, the clean areas. But there remains the fact that the so-called "hot" zone is growing and the only possible practical line of attack is a long-term one which is favoured in Tanganyika of contracting the buffer zone by driving Rinderpest north, back into the dirty area, the border of which will be the first line of defence. Certainly sacrifices are called for in order to do this, certainly much to hold it, but the northern group of Territories to do so, and if it is believed that the shorter line from Lake Tanganyika to Lake Nyasa would be easier, then that would be the policy to follow. The Secretary of State for the Colonies, a policy which would have the people in all these Territories will await with great interest the advice of the group of experts gathered together in Nairobi this week, confident that the belief that even Rinderpest cannot defeat the united efforts and resources of one half of Africa if there is a clear determination to co-operate, to sacrifice to succeed in the task of the biggest task facing civilisation in the Continent. After all, Rinderpest is not the only African problem which is the cause of the Tsetse fly and the stamping out of sleeping sickness was no less formidable, but if for making progress because economic necessity demands success and because nobody has lost heart in the struggle with nature in a new Continent where nature is still the biggest problem, particularly when the marginal areas are still unpopulated and the measure of the threat. Closer Settlement, more industrialization, population, development of the soil, clearing of the bush, and the other things which are the measure of the modernization of human life and society in the end defeat these scourges.

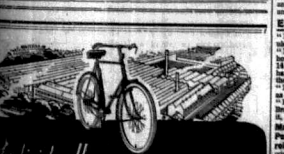

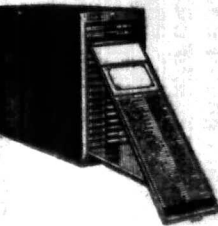

The British East African Meteorological Service station in Nairobi issued the following report on the weather:

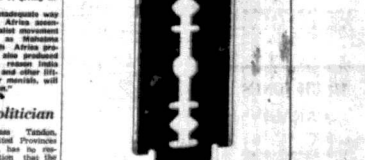

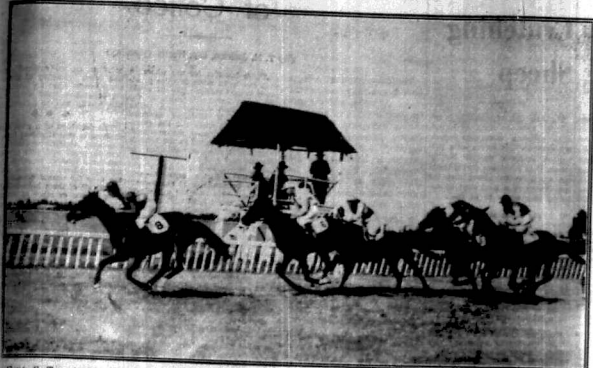

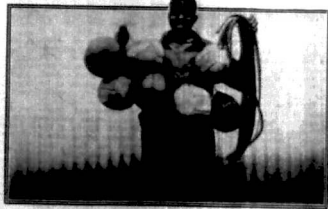

# Three Naval Armies to Japan

## Britain, France and America Request Information

STERILY-WORDED NOTES ARE BEING SENT TO JAPAN BY THE GOVERNMENTS OF BRITAIN, FRANCE AND THE UNITED STATES REQUESTING ASSURANCES THAT JAPAN IS NOT BUILDING WARSHIPS BEYOND TREATY LIMITS.

London, February 5. Great Britain and the United States have asked Japan to send them an assurance that she is not building warships which do not conform to the provisions of the 1922 London Naval Treaty.

If Japan does not give this assurance, the two countries propose to use their own treaty of earlier years as a basis for their own naval construction.

The French note to Japan on naval matters was delivered Tuesday, but official circles and the Japanese press are displaying the strictest reticence in regard to it.

It is becoming more and more evident that Japan will decline to answer the questions of the United States for information as to naval plans.

**Nothing to Reveal**  
The Japanese newspapers publish vague criticisms of the request, describing it as absurd and unnecessary. They also insist that they are unable to accept a suggestion, Japan is not a signatory to the London Treaty.
