Better Facilities for "Straight" News

COMMONS URGES ACTION

EFFECTIVE ACTION TO COUNTER FOREIGN PROPAGANDA WHICH AIMS AT DAMAGING BRITISH REPUTATION IS URGED IN A MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE HOUSE OF COMMONS.

In the course of the debate reference was made to the undue advantage enjoyed by foreign news agencies whose organizations are used and subsidized by totalitarian States for the purpose of deliberately suppressing or perverting British news and views.

Use of the methods of defeating this activity, it was suggested, would be facilitated should be afforded for the cheaper transmission of British news.

Government has promised that the matter will receive the most careful attention of a Cabinet Committee set up for the purpose.

London, February 16. The copy of the British news returned to the House of Commons that afternoon by Sir James Colville, leader of the Opposition, who also moved a resolution urging the Government to take steps to counter the propaganda of the foreign news agencies which are used and subsidized by totalitarian States for the purpose of deliberately suppressing or perverting British news and views, and culture abroad.





NAZIS DENY RUMOURS

REPORTS FROM GERMAN CITIES ALL ROUND GERMANY SPEAK OF SECRET POLICE ENQUIRIES INTO POLITICAL OPINIONS OF GERMAN ARMY OFFICERS. THESE REPORTS ARE COUPLED WITH THE RUMOUR THAT GERMAN HAS MOVED ALL HER FRONTIERS TO PREVENT THE ESCAPE OF ARMY OFFICERS.

Secret Talks With Dr. Schuschnigg

Berlin, February 13. A meeting took place on Saturday between Herr Hitler and the Austrian Chancellor, Dr. Schuschnigg at Herr Hitler's home at Berchtesgaden, where he is proceeding on his speech for the session of the Reichstag.

Germany Acclaims "Another Triumph For Herr Hitler"

PROTESTS IN VIENNA

"WAIT AND SEE" IS STILL THE ESSENCE OF THE ONLY ANSWERS THAT GOVERNMENT SPOKESMEN, IN BOTH LORDS AND COMMONS, GAVE TO A PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE THAT IS ANXIOUSLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE STATE OF AFFAIRS IN AUSTRIA, PARTICULARLY IN VIEW OF THE STREBA AGREEMENT BETWEEN BRITAIN, FRANCE AND ITALY. MR. ANTHONY EDEN, THE BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY, SAID ON THURSDAY THAT HE HOPED TO BE ABLE TO MAKE A STATEMENT ON FRIDAY. ON FRIDAY, HE SAID "WAIT TILL MONDAY."

The German Press is jubilant at what it calls a new triumph for Herr Hitler, and a French news agency report says that the French has obtained important posts for itself in the Austrian Cabinet and in the Federal Board, and that a new signatory for the Anti-Comintern Pact, as well as proposals of an Austro-German customs and currency union.

Strikes in Vienna have protested against "the betrayal of Austria to the Nazis" and trade unions have declared that they would adhere to a sacrifice to defend "the independence and dignity of Austria."

In London, February 12, The German Press is jubilant at what it calls the new triumph for Hitler, and says there must be no further concessions to Austria in such a treaty, and it is near to Russia.

It is unlikely that a Vienna report that Dr. Schuschnigg the Minister for the Interior would be Germany's representative of Austria in the German Government to report upon the progress made in Austria.

In Berlin, where Herr Reichstag president has stated that the Austro-German pact would have the effect of giving more posts to the Austrian Reichstag and would be a step towards the Federal Board.

It is also said Hitler had insisted that further posts in the Austrian Cabinet should be given to Nazis, that the Reichstag should be reconstituted and that the Secretary General of the Reichstag should be removed and the position given to a Nazi.

Dr. Schuschnigg's resignation as Austria's Chancellor has been announced. The Austrian Government has also announced its resignation to the British Government.

Trade union demonstrators took part in a demonstration in Vienna. It was later a meeting between Dr. Schuschnigg and the Minister for the Interior and the latter explained to them what he called the "new order" in the present instance.

Immediately afterwards, the demonstrators declared that they were not in favour of a people's party, and determined to support Dr. Schuschnigg in his office to secure the Austrian people's interests.




