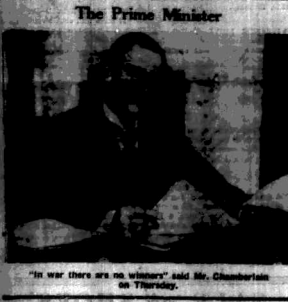

M. BLUM IS DETERMINED

to resist the League of Nations

Paris, March 25. M. Blum, French Minister of Finance, has announced his determination to resist the League of Nations in the event of a breach of the Franco-Czech treaty.

This was the substance of the statement on foreign affairs made by the Prime Minister on Thursday. He was two important qualifications.
