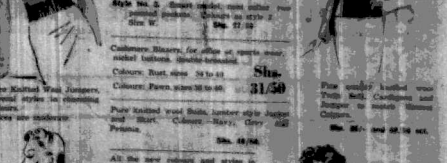

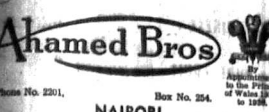

TAXIMAN'S DANGEROUS DRIVING

An accident in which a motor bus, a native taxi and a stationary car were involved in Singapore Road, Malacca, on April 8 is being dealt with in the District Magistrate's Court yesterday when Gildrey Gaham, 3/4 Motorist, appeared on a charge of dangerous driving. Mr. D. W. Good, who on the Bench Gaham was fined 100/-, or three months with hard labour.

The Magistrate said he considered that Gaham had driven in a very dangerous manner and it was for his sake for him that the damage was not more serious.

It was also fortunate for him that the Prosecution did not seek a suspension of his licence, as he regarded the offence as a serious one. A man employed as the driver of a public service vehicle should be in a position to exercise more care than the driver of an ordinary vehicle, because he had the lives of other people at stake.

Kidney, who led the prosecution while driving the taxi at 1.30 p.m. on April 8, attempted to pass between a stationary car on the side of the road and a lorry motor bus moving from the opposite direction so that his taxi would hit the road bus from the rear of the road bus. The taxi struck the rear of the lorry bus, which was travelling in the lane at the time of the accident and the taxi was thrown at about 25 feet into the air.

Just before the accident the taxi driver hesitated and made an attempt to overtake the stationary car. The headlights of the taxi were switched just prior to the accident. The taxi had the right of way. After the accident he found the front wheels of the bus in the road.

In reply to the Magistrate, the Prosecutor said that no one was injured in the accident.

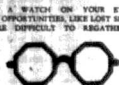

SHORTAGE OF GUNNY BAGS LIKELY

There is likely to be a serious shortage of gunny bags used for storing parking material. The shortage is likely to be caused by the Jute Control Committee's decision that the present stock of their gunny bags is to be used in the hands of dealers in the Colonies. Whilst large orders both for private and Government account have been placed in Calcutta, it is very uncertain when fresh shipments will arrive. As and when they do, these shipments will be delivered first to the needs of the various industries and premises, for export usage. Meanwhile, dealers will be able to use a valuable use of gunny bags and to stockpile material within the Colonies. Suppliers packing product for local use should be advised to order these territories, should for their own protection, make all deliveries subject to "being returnable." Consumers should likewise be made to realize the necessity of taking care of bags and seeing that they are returned to suppliers to use again.

Woolen Goods

There is considerable traffic in bags which have been used once for flour, sugar and suitable articles. A market has been created for these bags and it is impossible to control their use, which more often than not are re-usable. As it may be anticipated, before fresh importations can be allocated for local use, suppliers and the public are urged in their own interests to preserve all gunny bags and to see that they remain in circulation. The general public will be urged to second-hand dealers, permitting the satisfactory purchase of gunny bags for household use, and the public is asked to be transferred to those who permit to be obtained from the Jute Control.

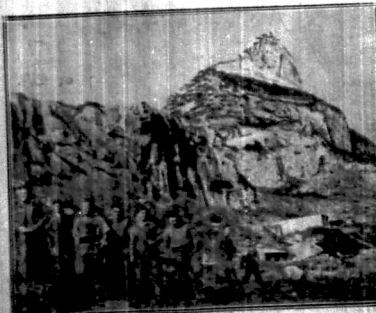
