BRITISH ADVANCE IN EGYPT

Round Trip Of 1,400 Miles To Bomb Danzig Submarine Building Yards

July 12. The British Air Force has carried out two more daring daylight raids over German territory, when two important submarine building yards on the shores of the Baltic were bombed.

The raids took place late on Saturday evening and were accompanied by very slight losses. One was made on Danzig, one several squadrons of the new, fast and heavy Lancaster bombers (led in the Augsburg raid) attacked the submarine building yards from below cloud level.

At the same time other squadrons were bombing the submarine yards at Flensburg, which is on the Baltic near the East Prussian and old Danish frontier.

DIRECT HITS SCORED

The attack was a heavy one and made from a low-level and great hits were scored on the airways.

From these two operations, three of our bombers failed to return.

The raid on Danzig is the longest daylight raid (1,400 miles) made by the Royal Air Force and involves a 700 mile journey each way, mainly over enemy or enemy-occupied territory. The previous longest daylight raid was that on Augsburg, which was 500 miles each way. (Reuter.)
