Loan to Burma a kind of credit'

The Government loans to
Burma will be "a kind of
credit," Mr. Francis Nelles, the
Rapporteur on the Inter-Parliamentary
Rapport on 16th May before the
Commonwealth Conference.

"The loan is drawn on very

CHURCHILL FIRES THE FIRST SHOTS Election campaign broadcast

BRITAIN TOLD 'NO NATION EVER IN SUCH ECONOMIC PERIL'

BRITAIN'S wartime Premier, Mr. Winston Churchill, declared in a speech broadcast from London yesterday that the nation had responded Britain's greatest economic crisis since the days of the Napoleonic Wars by the almost unprecedented foreign charity, and that the Government was determined to meet the emergency without foreign assistance.

"We have been told on all sides that there is no alternative but to go to the British people for help," he said. "I believe that in this country there is no alternative but to go to the British people for help."

Churchill based his speech on the idea of an all-powerful State which could do everything which distributed everything, which directed everything and which controlled every aspect of society and variety of our

lives. "The greater number of us are not so much afraid of the future as we are of the past," he said. "We are afraid of the past because it has brought us to the present."

"Out of harmony"

"There are some who would like to see us go back to the days of the Great War, when we were at war with Germany, and when we were at war with America," he said. "There are others who would like to see us go back to the days of the First World War, when we were at war with America, and when we were at war with Germany."

"Peace with Russia"

"The Government of today were the Soviet Union, and a fight against the Soviet Union is a fight against the Communists," he said.

The Labour Government, the speaker said, still had a chance to stop the Communists from getting into power in Britain.

British policy is unchanged

BRITISH policy remains unchanged despite the recent statement by the United States Secretary of State, Mr. Dean Acheson, that the U.S. would not support any move to end the Korean conflict.
