Promise to work on German problem

ARMS CUT AND ATOMIC WEAPON BAN SOUGHT

FRANCE has issued a new call for East-West talks, promising the west to "do all in our power" to reach agreement on Germany, a ban on atomic and hydrogen weapons and a reduction of armaments.

The call came as Britain, the United States and Moscow proposed a visit to Russia regarding recent Communist terms - and on which the Soviet Foreign Ministry sought a decision in its statement published in all Moscow newspapers yesterday.

The statement, issued in the wake of the French rejection of the European Defence Community Treaty, West German contingents - a German military and rearmament would have "increased immeasurably the threat of a new European war, and at the same time, the threat of a new world war."

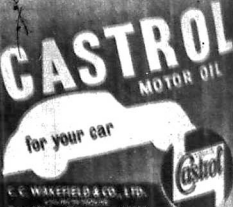

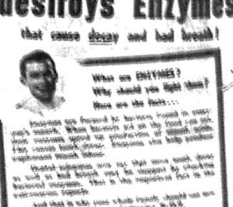

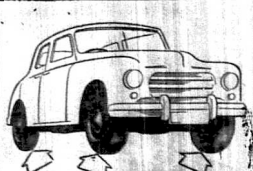

BUSINESSMEN TACKLE FUEL PROBLEMS

Demand for coal exceeds supply

BRITISH Chambers of Commerce opened a two-day conference in Sheffield yesterday to tackle the problem of future coal supplies for industry.

An increasing demand, plus a diminishing supply makes it necessary for Britain to import coal this year. This aspect of the conference was given top priority, over discussing a general review of fuel and power prices.

There has been suggestion that the price of fuel to be raised in the 1965-66 season. This aspect of the conference has been competition for world markets. The price of fuel has fallen down, is virtually dropping in a number of places. Two groups of delegates are meeting first efficiency, price of coal and the use of alternative fuels in particular.

From there he travels to Delhi, and then to other educational centres in Calcutta, Patna, Bangalore, Lucknow, Aggra, Bombay, Ludhiana, Allahabad, Lahore, Karachi, Haridwar, Madras, Madurai and Bangalore.

SALVATIONISTS IN KENYA ARE OPTIMISTIC OF FUTURE

DESPITE Mau Mau Interference

Kenya could double its present 2,000 Salvation Army adherents in four years, if the funds and missionaries were available. This was said by J. J. Allan, whose 15-day tour of Kenya ended yesterday.

Mr. Allan, who flew from Nairobi on Tuesday, said that the Salvation Army had already had the largest following in Kenya since the six African territories.

A bus strike in London over a young engaged couple who departed overtime because they were saving up to be married ended when about 200 men from a North-West London garage decided after a 24-hour meeting to go back to work.

The strike began over the 24-hour overtime which the Christian Church, on Oct 23 and 24, refused to allow an overtime ban.

The busmen struck in protest. The union said they wanted an assurance at the strike meeting from the couple that they would observe the ban.

But neither spoke at the meeting. Afterwards a strike official said: "We are letting bygones be bygones."

More than 100 buses on five routes were affected by the strike, which was the longest in London's history. Thousands of Londoners to walk to work.

The overtime ban was imposed by about a quarter of London's 114 bus depots as a protest against wage rises and staff shortages. (Reuters)

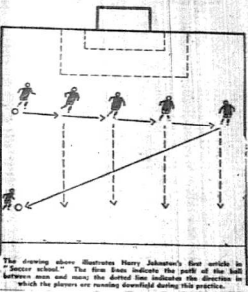

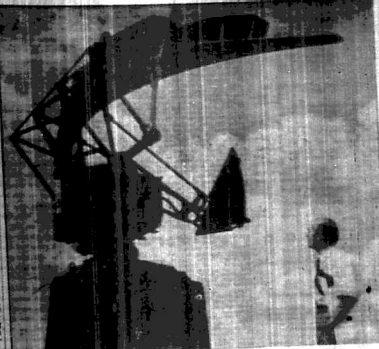
