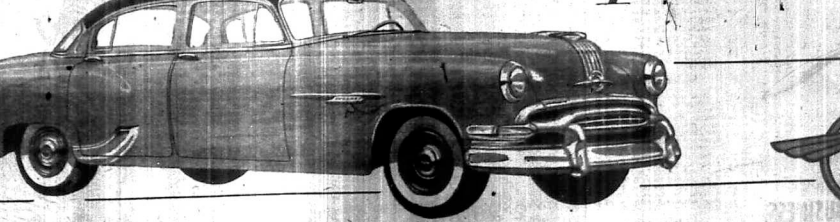

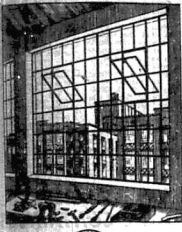

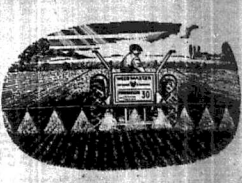

229 KIKUYU DENOUNCE MAU MAU

Move comes after Muguga sweep

A TOTAL of 107 men and 123 women have reported to the Kenya Police Inspector General that they were actively involved in Mau Mau activities in the area of their post.

All were forward trainees with the clearance by security forces of armed guerrillas from the nearby Mombasa Forest, as reported to last night's official communique.

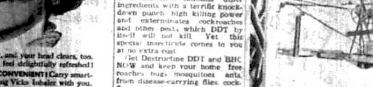

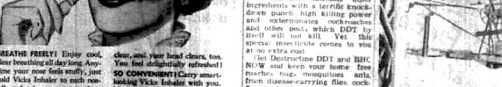

From DEBRET To The 'TOWER'

MORE BIG NAMES AS HITLER'S HOSTAGES

GILES ROMILLY and MICHAEL ALEXANDER meet in the frowning Castle of Colditz, towers of the Tower, and continue the remarkable story of the "Prominents"

THIS Tower, which at various times had housed Saxons, Jews, fallen warriors, Communists, lunatics, and dissident Czechs, was in the winter of 1941-42 the seat of 600 prisoners of war who had been sent to it from milder places either on account of escaping or because they had otherwise incurred German displeasure.

A beesting spot, overlooking the small town of Colditz, in the very middle of Germany, it was intended to be a firm and final instrument for these prisoners, whose inclusion was also, in the German view, a quarantine measure.

The German word *Prominents* was perhaps never meaning more or less what its sound suggests first applied to Giles Romilly and Michael Alexander. It conveyed a distinction, not that we were considered individually especially dangerous, but that we were "concentrated" on account of several offences.

We were held segregated in a small room instead of living in the communal quarters, were locked in every night with a guard postulated outside a glass, chronologically the first few days after reaching it, I did not see any other prisoners at a room at the end of a long cell had a barred window view from on the outside was first lined with white paint to make it conspicuous to visitors. It also had a table, a chair, a bedstead, a stove, and a spy-hole.
