

S. RHODESIA LAND BILL OPPOSED

Second reading after division

AFTER a division in which six Government Party members crossed the floor of the House of Assembly, the Rhodesia Land Apportionment Amendment Bill was read a second time in Parliament at Salisbury.

In his reply to the debate the Minister of Home Affairs, Mr. P. B. Fletcher, announced that Government was prepared to accept the recommendations of the committee, but at the divided six to five, it was voted that the bill against the bill, voting in the Government Party. Voting was 15 to 14.

Rift Valley successes against 'splinter' gangs

MORALE OF AFRICANS BOOSTED

AFRICAN Home-Guards in the Rift Valley Province are demonstrating more and more their value against the "splinter" groups which are operating by security forces, particularly the heavy bombing, in the Abberloneys. For some time past, the Diggers and Balati areas and at Narasha, have been recently these in Mai Forest areas have been in action against the rebels, and many have slipped through into forested areas, some of which are still controlled by the Abberloneys themselves.

One example, he said, was that the Diggers and Balati areas had Home Guards in the Abberloneys, and these had been in contact with the rebels. He stressed that the Home Guards had done very well, and that the Guards' first duty was as their home defence units.



U.S. gift of atomic fuel to agency members POWER EQUAL TO TEN BOMBS

AMERICA has allocated 200 lb. of fissionable material to other countries. This was disclosed by Mr. George E. K. Lodge, the United States chargé d'affaires at the Nations' Capital, in the Western plan for developing the peaceful use of atomic energy.

According to a Norwegian scientist, America's offer would be equivalent to ten atomic bombs. It depended on the estimate, however, of the value and significance of the offer.

Reply to criticisms

Mr. Lodge referred to Soviet accusations that President Eisenhower's plan to develop atomic energy in even greater part in the United States was aimed at "the destruction of man." He added: "The American Government has been asked to comment on such statements, and we have done so. We have also made representations to our own Government that a great deal of work is being done in this field."

The chairman of the all-party committee on atomic energy of the United States Senate, Mr. Joseph L. Mankiewicz, told members of his committee yesterday that he expected to receive a report from the committee's investigation that would make it clear that the Soviet charge was "utterly groundless."

Mr. Mankiewicz said: "The small re- sults which we have obtained up to now are worth while."

Chairman of the all-party committee on atomic energy of the House of Representatives, Mr. John W. McCormack, said: "We have been able to obtain a report from the Soviet delegation, Mr. Vassilyev, which is very interesting."

Russia unrepresented

He said it was not necessary to reveal it was not necessary to reveal the national control of atomic energy and the Soviet Union had not been invited to the conference before they could have been invited.

The next gives Mrs. R. Bourne her oil painting called "Frangipani" in which soft glowing colours are used to create a most peaceful still portrait.


This is a vivid and striking portrait in oil of Mrs. Alex Hunter by Mrs. Joyce Burt.






