### Premier wins extra powers fight Promise of effort to end fear

**A PROMISE** to work with all-comers in an honest effort to remove fear and distrust among nations was made by Dwight Eisenhower in his inaugural speech in Washington yesterday as the 34th President of the United States. Nevertheless, he declared, he would never please an aggressor.

More than 50,000 people thronged the arena of the capital to witness the inauguration, and more across the United States watched through a vast television link-up.

President Eisenhower made his speech on the steps of the Capitol, and was escorted to his new home, the White House, in a limousine procession which included 27,000 members of the armed forces, 150 elephants. "I took the oath of the life of a new President. The parade also included the world's first atomic gas turbine car carrying on a trolley, 60 feet long.

The day opened with services in the Washington Metropolitan Convention Center, and then with members of the Administration in the White House. A special service at the National Protestant Cathedral included a prayer by the Rev. Martin Luther King.

At 11 o'clock, a grand parade was held in the streets of Washington. The parade was led by the Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr., with a marching band of 20,000.

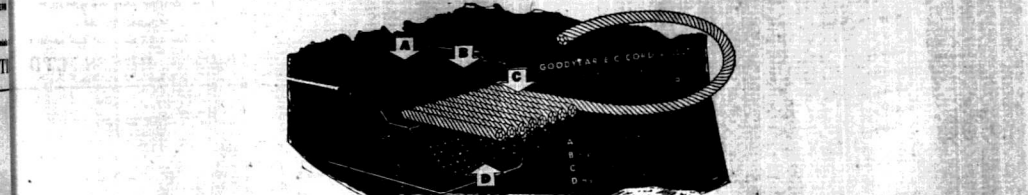

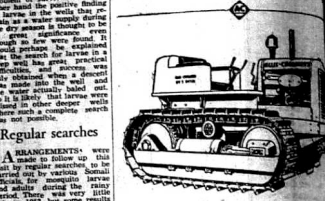

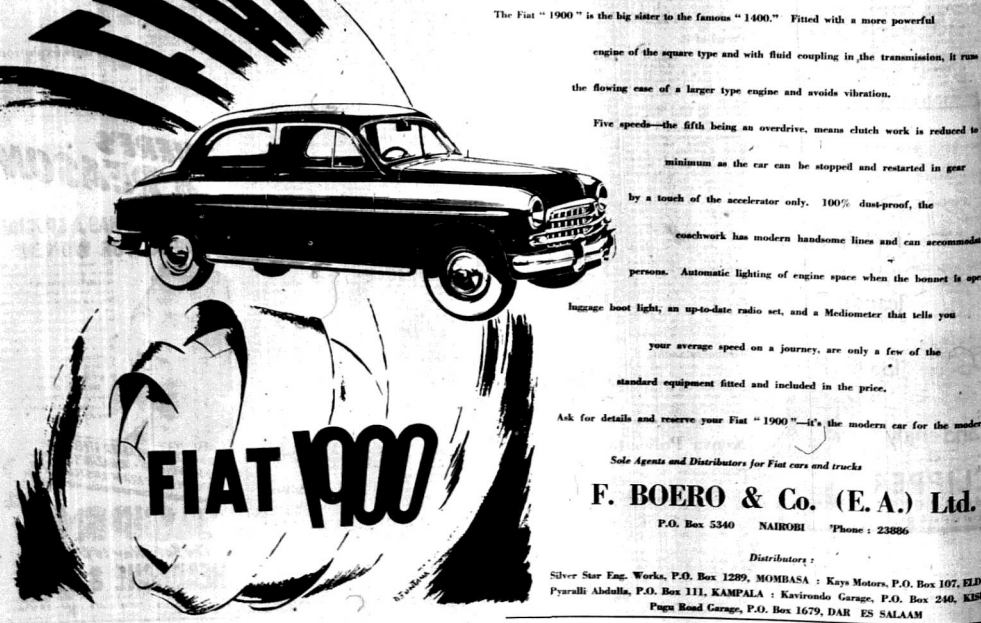
